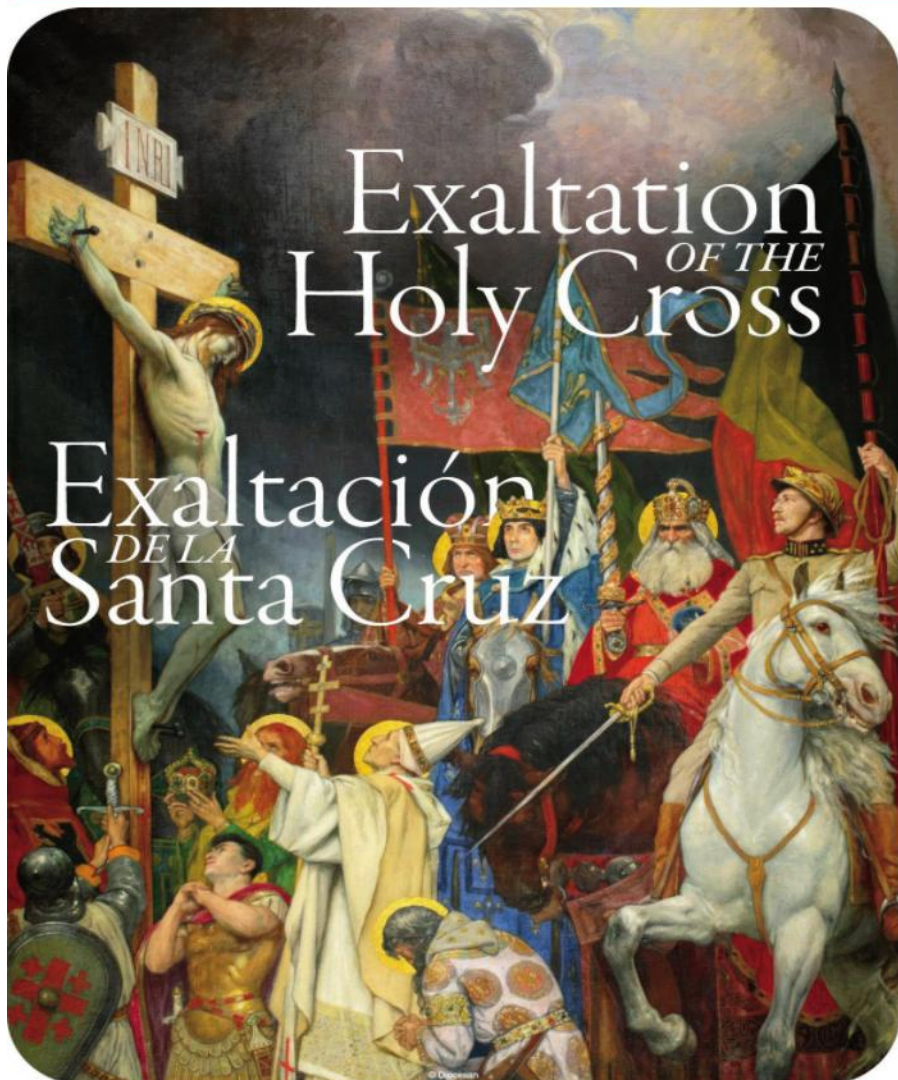

On 13 September 335, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher (also called the Church of the Resurrection) was dedicated. The following day, the cross that Empress Helena had discovered on 14 September 320, was venerated in a solemn ceremony. In 614, the Persian King, Chosroes II, waged war on the Romans.

After conquering Jerusalem, he confiscated many treasures, among which was the Cross of Jesus. The Byzantine emperor Heraclius initiated peace negotiations, but was rejected. He then waged war and won near Nineveh, asking for the restitution of the Cross, which then returned to Jerusalem.

Today, the cruelty of the Cross is not what is exalted, but the Love that God manifested to humanity by accepting death on the Cross: "Who, though in the form of God, emptied himself, taking the form of a slave. **This is the glory of the Cross of Jesus!**"

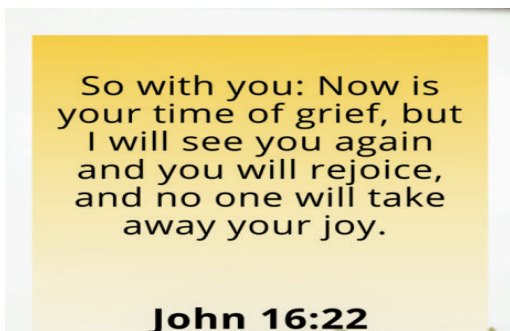

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Lectionary: 638

Reading 1

Numbers 21:4b-9

With their patience worn out by the journey,
the people complained against God and Moses,
"Why have you brought us up from Egypt to die
in this desert,
where there is no food or water?
We are disgusted with this wretched food!"

In punishment the LORD sent among the people
saraph serpents,
which bit the people so that many of them died.
Then the people came to Moses and said,
"We have sinned in complaining against the
LORD and you.
Pray the LORD to take the serpents from us."
So Moses prayed for the people, and the LORD
said to Moses,
"Make a saraph and mount it on a pole,
and if any who have been bitten look at it, they
will live."
Moses accordingly made a bronze serpent and
mounted it on a pole,
and whenever anyone who had been bitten by a
serpent
looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.

Philippians 2:6-11

Brothers and sisters:

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God,
did not regard equality with God something to be
grasped.

Rather, he emptied himself,
taking the form of a slave,
coming in human likeness;
and found human in appearance,
he humbled himself,
becoming obedient to death,
even death on a cross.

Because of this, God greatly exalted him
and bestowed on him the name that is above every
name, that at the name of Jesus
every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on
earth and under the earth, and every tongue con-
fess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God
the Father.

John 3:13-17

Jesus said to Nicodemus:

"No one has gone up to heaven
except the one who has come down from heav-
en, the Son of Man.
And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the
desert,
so must the Son of Man be lifted up,
so that everyone who believes in him may have
eternal life."

For God so loved the world that he gave his
only Son,
so that everyone who believes in him might not
perish
but might have eternal life.
For God did not send his Son into the world to
condemn the world,
but that the world might be saved through
him.

Sept. 15 Our Lady of Sorrows

Q. Why Saturday is always Blessed Virgin Mary Day?

A. Saturday, Nov. 27, 1830, was the day before Advent began that year. That Saturday our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in the chapel of the motherhouse of the Daughters of Charity in Paris to give her the Miraculous Medal. Describing the design, Our Lady also said the medal was to have the inscription, "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." The medal was to be spread far and wide. It was, and continues to be. **Saturday**, Sept. 19, 1846, was the day Mary appeared as Our Lady of La Salette to the young shepherd children Melanie Calvat and Maximum Giraud with a major message about changing living patterns and turning back to God.

Saturday, Dec. 9, 1531, Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared for the first time to St. Juan Diego. (The Julian calendar was still the calendar in use during that time.) She told Juan to tell the bishop to have a chapel built there, "For in truth I am your compassionate Mother, yours and of all who live together in this land and of any others who love me, seek me, and call on me with confidence and devotion. In that house I will listen to their weeping and their sadness, I will give them help in their troubles and a cure for their misfortunes."

Saturdays are surely Mary's days right from the start.

Caminando con la Palabra

Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz

14 de septiembre de 2025

(Números 21, 4-9; Salmo 77, 1-2. 34-35. 36-37. 38; Filipenses 2, 6-11; Juan 3, 13-17)

Parece peculiar, en este tiempo litúrgico ordinario, encontrarnos de repente una celebración como la de hoy. La Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz es de gran importancia tanto para el rito de Occidente (Latino), que es el nuestro, como para los ritos de Oriente (Rito Griego Ortodoxo y otros). En muchos de los países de habla hispana, cabe apuntar, se observa algo similar no el 14 de septiembre, sino el 3 de mayo

(el día de la Cruz de Mayo).

La fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz conmemora dos sucesos históricos. El primero es el descubrimiento, en el año 320, de la verdadera Cruz, del Calvario y de la tumba de Cristo. Santa Elena, madre del emperador Constantino, los encontró bajo un templo erigido a la diosa Venus,

donde habían sido enterrados por los romanos. El Segundo acontecimiento que origina la celebración de esta fiesta es la dedicación de una iglesia en ese lugar en el año 335. Hoy en día, esa iglesia, que existe desde entonces, recibe el nombre de Basílica del Santo Sepulcro, y alberga el Calvario, la tumba de Jesús y la cisterna en la cual Santa Elena encontró los instrumentos de la Pasión de Jesús, incluida la Cruz.

Las lecturas ofrecidas hoy por la Iglesia apuntan a que la Cruz, instrumento de humillación y tortura, se transforma, gracias al sacrificio de

Jesucristo, en medio de redención para el mundo entero pues, “así como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser levantado el Hijo del hombre, para que todo el que crea en él tenga vida eterna (Juan 3, 14-15).” Si bien para los romanos el madero es la manera de aplicar la condena a un reo de muerte, el Evangelio en cambio indica que “Dios no envió a su Hijo para condenar al mundo, sino para que el mundo se salvara por él (Juan 3, 17).”

Contemplemos por tanto en esta Eucaristía cómo la Cruz abre la puerta para que podamos ser dignos merecedores y partícipes de las promesas de Cristo. Repi-



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
