Lectionary: 135

Reading 1

Amos 8:4-7

Hear this, you who trample upon the needy and destroy the poor of the land!

"When will the new moon be over," you ask, "that we may sell our grain, and the sabbath, that we may display the wheat?

We will diminish the ephah, add to the shekel, and fix our scales for cheating!

We will buy the lowly for silver, and the poor for a pair of sandals; even the refuse of the wheat we will sell!"

Reading 2

1 Timothy 2:1-8

Beloved: First of all, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity.

This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God.

For this I was appointed preacher and apostle — I am speaking the truth, I am not lying —, teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

Gospel

Luke 16:1-13

Jesus said to his disciples, "A rich man had a steward who was reported to him for squandering his property. He summoned him and said, 'What is this I hear about you? Prepare a full account of your stewardship, because you can no longer be my steward.'

The steward said to himself, 'What shall I do now that my master is taking the position of steward away from me?

I am not strong enough to dig and I am ashamed to beg. I know what I shall do so that, when I am removed from the stewardship, they may welcome me into their homes.'

He called in his master's debtors one by one.

To the first he said, 'How much do you owe my master?' He replied, 'One hundred measures of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Here is your promissory note. Sit down and quickly write one for fifty.'

Then to another the steward said, 'And you, how much do you owe?' He replied, 'One hundred kors of wheat.' The steward said to him, 'Here is your promissory note; write one for eighty.'

And the master commended that dishonest steward for acting prudently.

"For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones. If, therefore, you are not trustworthy with dishonest wealth, who will trust you with true wealth?

If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours?

No servant can serve two masters.

He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon."

Sept. 15 Our Lady of Sorrows

Q. Why Saturday is always Blessed Virgin Mary Day?

A. Saturday, Nov. 27, 1830, was the day before Advent began that year. That Saturday our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in the chapel of the motherhouse of the Daughters of Charity in Paris to give her the Miraculous Medal. Describing the design, Our Lady also said the medal was to have the inscription, "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." The medal was to be spread far and wide. It was, and continues to be.

Saturday, Sept. 19, 1846, was the day Mary appeared as Our Lady of La Salette to the young shepherd children Melanie Calvat and Maximum Giraud with a major message about changing living patterns and turning back to God.

Saturday, Dec. 9, 1531, Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared for the first time to St. Juan Diego. (The Julian calendar was still the calendar in use during that time.) She told Juan to tell the bishop to have a chapel built there, "For in truth I am your compassionate Mother, yours and of all who live together in this land and of any others who love me, seek me, and call on me with confidence and devotion. In that house I will listen to their weeping and their sadness, I will give them help in their troubles and a cure for their misfortunes."

Saturdays are surely Mary's days right from the start.

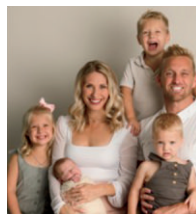

Caminando con la Palabra

XXV Domingo Ordinario

(Amós 8, 4-7; Salmo 112, 1-2. 4-6. 7-8; 1 Timoteo 2, 1-8; Lucas 16, 1-13)

La reflexión de hoy está adaptada de una alocución de Su Santidad Benedicto XVI pronunciada anterior al rezo del Ángelus del 23 de septiembre de 2007.

Narrando la parábola de un administrador injusto, pero muy astuto, Cristo enseña a sus discípulos cuál es el mejor modo de utilizar las riquezas materiales, es decir, compartirlas con los pobres, obteniendo así su amistad con vistas al reino de los cielos. El dinero no es “injusto” en sí mismo, pero más que cualquier otra cosa puede encerrar al hombre en un egoísmo ciego. Se trata, pues, de realizar una especie de “conversión” de los bienes económicos en vez de usarlos sólo para el propio interés.

Es preciso pensar también en las necesidades de los pobres, imitando a Cristo mismo, el cual, como escribe san Pablo, “siendo rico, por ustedes se hizo pobre, a fin de que se enriquecieran con su pobreza (2 Co 8, 9).” Parece una paradoja Cristo no nos ha enriquecido con su riqueza, sino con su pobreza, es decir, con su amor, que lo impulsó a entregarse totalmente a nosotros.

La emergencia del hambre y la emergencia ecológica muestran cada vez con más evidencia que cuando predomina la lógica del lucro aumenta la desproporción entre ricos y pobres y una dañina explotación del planeta. En cambio, cuando predomina la lógica del compartir y de la solidaridad, es posible corregir el rumbo y orientarlo hacia un desarrollo equitativo y sostenible.

Que María santísima, quien en el *Magnificat* proclama que el Señor “a los hambrientos los colma de bienes y a los ricos los despide vacíos (Lc 1, 53),” ayude a los cristianos a usar con sabiduría evangélica, es decir, con generosa solidaridad, los bienes terrenos, e inspire a los gobernantes y a los expertos en economía a desarrollar estrategias que favorezcan el auténtico progreso de todos los pueblos.
