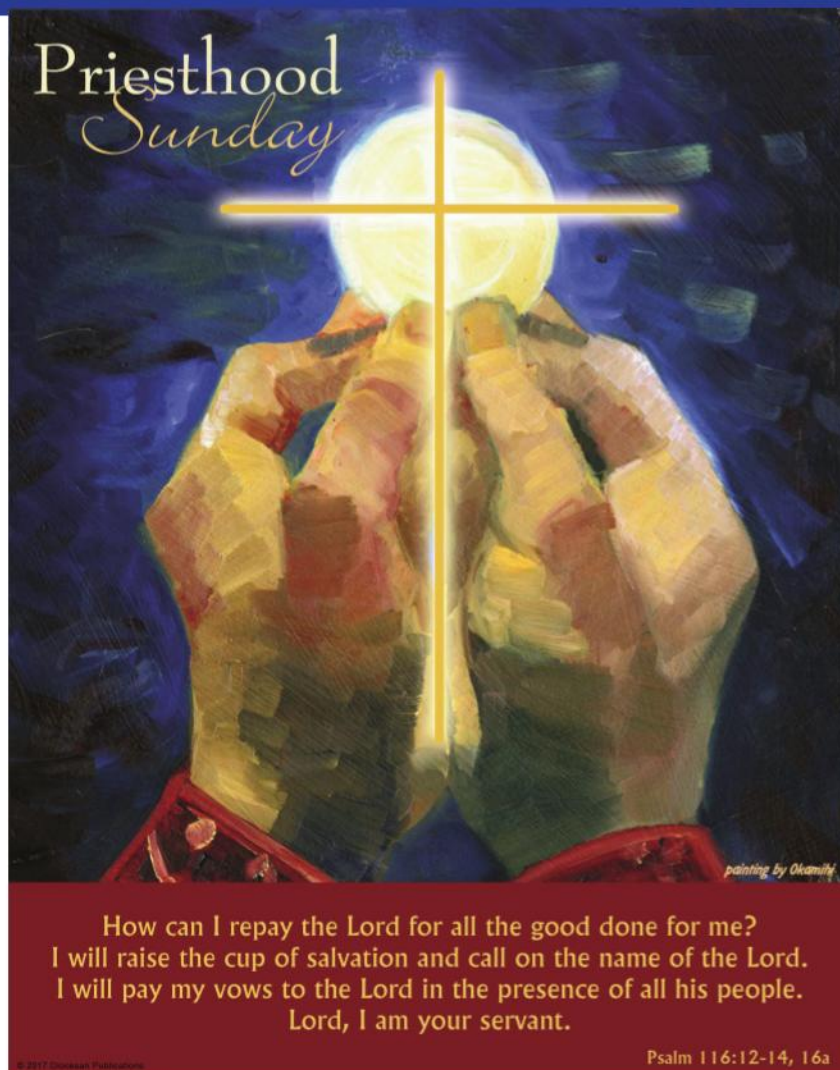

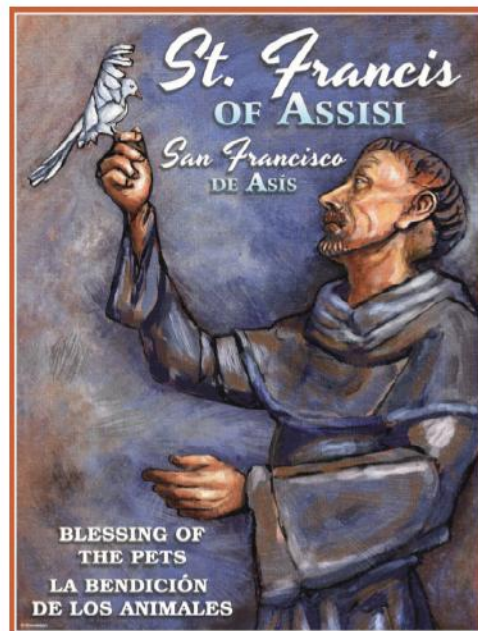

Lectionary: 138

Reading 1

Amos 6:1a, 4-7

Thus says the LORD the God of hosts: Woe to the complacent in Zion! Lying upon beds of ivory, stretched comfortably on their couches, they eat lambs taken from the flock, and calves from the stall! Improvising to the music of the harp, like David, they devise their own accompaniment. They drink wine from bowls and anoint themselves with the best oils; yet they are not made ill by the collapse of Joseph! Therefore, now they shall be the first to go into exile, and their wanton revelry shall be done away with.

Reading 2

1 Timothy 6:11-16

But you, man of God, pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Compete well for the faith. Lay hold of eternal life, to which you were called when you made the noble confession in the presence of many witnesses. I charge you before God, who gives life to all things, and before Christ Jesus, who gave testimony under Pontius Pilate for the noble confession, to keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearance of our Lord Jesus Christ that the blessed and only ruler will make manifest at the proper time, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, and whom no human being has seen or can see. To him be honor and eternal power. Amen.

Gospel

Luke 16:19-31

Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores.

When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried, and from the netherworld, where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. And he cried out, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me. Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am suffering torment in these flames.' Abraham replied, 'My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented.

Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours.' He said, 'Then I beg you, father, send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they too come to this place of torment.' But Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them.'

He said, 'Oh no, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'

Then Abraham said, 'If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.'"

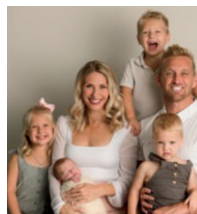

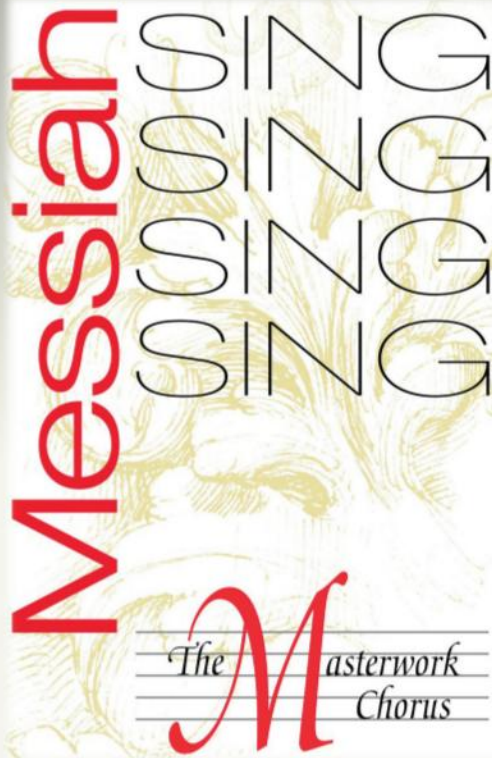

Caminando con la Palabra

XXVI Domingo Ordinario - 28 de septiembre de 2025

(Amós 6, 1. 4-7; Salmo 145, 7. 8-9a. 9bc-10; 1 Timoteo 6, 11-16; Lucas 16, 19-31)

(Compartimos un texto adaptado de la Audiencia General de Papa Francisco del 18 de mayo de 2016)

Consideramos hoy en la parábola del hombre rico y del pobre Lázaro. La vida de estas dos personas parece recorrer caminos paralelos. La puerta de la casa del rico está siempre cerrada al pobre, que yace allí afuera, buscando comer cualquier sobra de la mesa del rico. Este lleva puestos vestidos de lujo, mientras que Lázaro está cubierto de llagas; el rico cada día banquetea abundantemente, mientras que Lázaro muere de hambre. Lázaro representa bien el grito silencioso de los pobres de todos los tiempos y la contradicción de un mundo en el que las inmensas riquezas y recursos están en las manos de pocos.

Un día aquel hombre rico murió: los pobres y los ricos mueren, tienen el mismo destino, como todos nosotros, no hay excepciones a esto. Y entonces aquel hombre se dirigió a Abraham suplicándole con el apelativo de «padre» (v. 24.27). Reivindica, por lo tanto, ser su hijo, perteneciente al pueblo de Dios. Y sin embargo en vida no mostró ninguna consideración hacia Dios, más bien hizo de sí mismo el centro de todo, cerrado en su mundo de lujo y de derroche. Excluyendo a Lázaro, no tuvo en cuenta ni al Señor, ni a su ley. ¡Ignorar al pobre es despreciar a Dios! Lázaro, que se halla ante la puerta, es una llamada viviente al rico para que se acuerde de Dios, pero el rico no acoge esta llamada. Será condenado por lo tanto no por sus riquezas, sino por haber sido incapaz de sentir compasión por Lázaro y socorrerlo.

Hasta que Lázaro estuvo bajo su casa, para el rico había posibilidad de salvación, abrir la puerta, ayudar a Lázaro, pero ahora que ambos están muertos, la situación se ha vuelto irreparable. La misericordia de Dios hacia nosotros está relacionada con nuestra misericordia hacia el prójimo; cuando falta esta, también aquella no encuentra espacio en nuestro corazón cerrado, no puede entrar. Si yo no abro de par en par la puerta de mi corazón al pobre, aquella puerta permanece cerrada. También para Dios.

Para convertirnos, no debemos esperar eventos prodigiosos, sino abrir el corazón a la Palabra de Dios, que nos llama a amar a Dios y al prójimo. La Palabra de Dios puede hacer revivir un corazón marchito y curarlo de su ceguera. Así en el cambio de las suertes que la parábola describe se esconde el misterio de nuestra salvación, en que Cristo une la pobreza a la misericordia.



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
