

**READING I**  
**Sirach 15:15-20**

If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you; if you trust in God, you too shall live; he has set before you fire and water to whichever you choose, stretch forth your hand. Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him. Immense is the wisdom of the Lord; he is mighty in power, and all-seeing. **GOSPEL**  
**Matthew 5:17-37**

Jesus said to his disciples:

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill. Amen, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or the smallest part of a letter will pass from the law, until all things have taken place.

Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. But whoever obeys and teaches these commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven. I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment. But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; and whoever says to his brother, 'Raqa,' will be answerable to the Sanhedrin; and whoever says, 'You fool,' will be liable to fiery Gehenna. Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

Settle with your opponent quickly while on the way to court. Otherwise your opponent will hand you over to the judge, and the judge will hand you over to the guard, and you will be thrown into prison. Amen, I say to you, you will not be released until you have paid the last penny.

"You have heard that it was said, You shall not commit adultery. But I say to you, everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body thrown into Gehenna. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body go into Gehenna. "It was also said, Whoever divorces his wife must give her a bill of divorce. But I say to you, whoever divorces his wife - unless the marriage is unlawful - causes her to commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery. "Again you have heard that it was said to your ancestors, Do not take a false oath, but make good to the Lord all that you vow. But I say to you, do not swear at all; not by heaven, for it is God's throne; nor by the earth, for it is his footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.

Do not swear by your head, for you cannot make a single hair white or black. Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the evil one."

## **Msgr. Tom's Musings: GOD'S GIFTS TO THE FAITHFUL OF OUR DIOCESE**

This February has become a month of real joy for our diocese and for the wider Church. We celebrate not only an ordination of a priest that recently has taken place (Father Jedidiah Preble), but we prepare to welcome a new bishop (Manuel de Jesus Rodriguez) into our midst— two gifts given by God, through the Church, for the service of God's people.

We rejoice first because God is still calling. In a world that often questions commitment, sacrifice, and lifelong service, God continues to place a call on the hearts of men and women. A new priest and a new bishop-to-be come to us as living proof that God has not abandoned His Church, that the Holy Spirit is still at work, and that Christ continues to say, "Come, follow me."

But we also rejoice because these men are sent to us. A priest or bishop is not ordained for himself. He is ordained for the Church, for the people he will serve, baptize, teach, forgive, confirm and accompany. His life is now bound to ours. Our joys will become his joys; our sorrows will become his prayers. When he stands at the altar, he carries our lives with him— our families, our struggles, our hopes—lifting them up to God; and that is no small thing. The joy of welcoming any new priest or bishop is also a reminder of what priesthood truly is. He is not a performer, not a manager, not a spiritual service provider. He is, above all, a servant—a man configured to Christ the Good Shepherd, who lays down His life for the sheep. Through his hands, Christ will bless; through his voice, Christ will teach; through his presence, Christ will remain close to His heart.

Welcoming a new bishop or priest is not just about applause or warm words—though those matter; it's about shared responsibility. If we want joyful bishops and priests, we must be a joyful, praying, and supportive community. We are called to pray for him, encourage him, be patient with him, and walk with him as he grows into this sacred ministry.

Our soon-to-be ordained bishop brings energy, generosity, and zeal—but he also brings humanity. He will need our prayers on difficult days, our understanding when ministry is demanding, and our trust as he learns and serves. When we support our bishops and priests, we strengthen the whole Church.

These special moments invite each of us to ask: How is God calling me to serve? The priesthood reminds us that every Christian has a vocation, every baptized person is called to holiness, and every life is meant to be given as a gift. So, this month, in the Diocese of Palm Beach, let's give thanks, rejoice, welcome, and especially, let's pray.

May our newly ordained leaders always know the joy of that special calling, the strength of Christ who called him, and the love of the people he is sent to serve. May our joy deepen our faith, renew our hope, and remind us that God is still doing something beautiful among us. Mary, Queen of the Apostles, pray for us!








Payment breakdown
