READING 1 ACTS 2:42-47

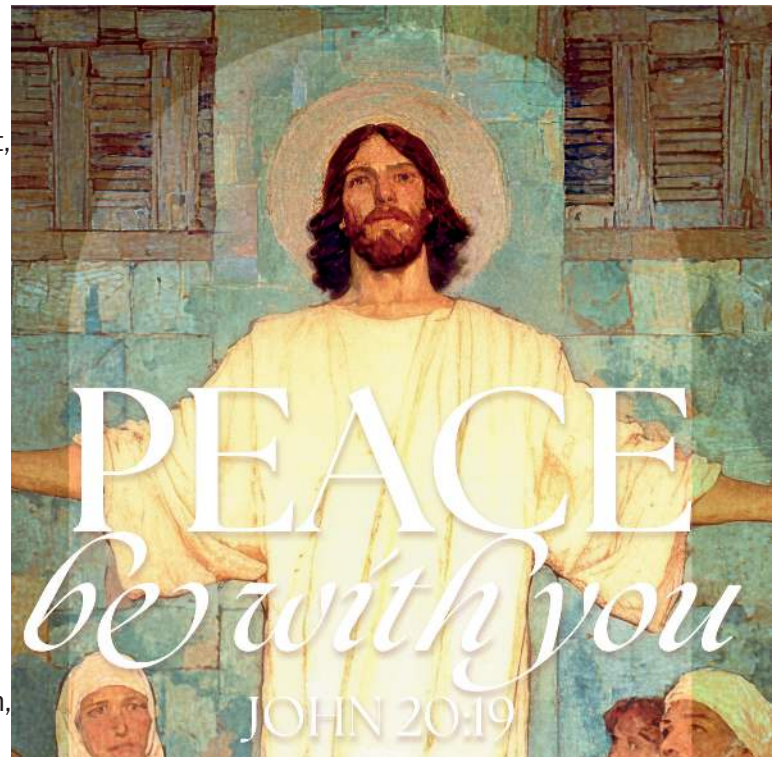
They devoted themselves

number those who were being saved.

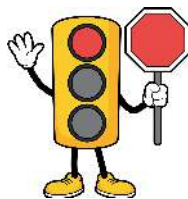
READING 2 1 Peter 1:3-9

El Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, también llamado Segundo Domingo de Pascua, se celebra principalmente mediante la participación plena en la Santa Misa, que es el "locus natural" para expresar la aceptación de la misericordia del Redentor, vertida en la muerte y resurrección de Cristo.¹ Esta fiesta, instituida por san Juan Pablo II en el año 2000 durante la canonización de santa Faustina Kowalska, une la liturgia pascual con la devoción a la Misericordia Divina, fomento de la fe, el perdón y la esperanza en la redención.^{1 2 3}

La dimensión litúrgica: La Eucaristía como centro

La celebración principal es la Misa del Segundo Domingo de Pascua, integrada en la octava de Pascua, donde la liturgia revela la misericordia de Dios a través de las lecturas bíblicas que destacan la comunidad primitiva, la esperanza viva y la fe en el Resucitado.¹

Primera lectura (Hch 2,42-47): Describe la vida de la primera comunidad cristiana, dedicada a la enseñanza de los apóstoles, la fracción del pan (Eucaristía), las oraciones y la comunión de bienes, con signos y maravillas que atraen conversiones diarias.⁴

Salmo responsorial (Sal 118,2-4.13-15.22-24): Proclama el amor misericordioso eterno de Dios: "Que lo diga Israel: 'Su misericordia perdura por siempre'".⁵

Segunda lectura (1 Pe 1,3-9): Alaba a Dios por la misericordia que da un nuevo nacimiento a la esperanza viva mediante la resurrección de Cristo, protegiendo la fe en medio de pruebas para una salvación eterna.⁶

Evangelio (Jn 20,19-31): Jesús aparece a los discípulos, les da paz, les concede el Espíritu Santo para perdonar pecados y convence a Tomás de su resurrección, bendiciendo a quienes creen sin ver.⁷

En esta Misa, la liturgia hace "cantar de la misericordia del Señor" (cf. Sal 89,2), presentando al Cristo pascual como la encarnación definitiva de la misericordia.¹ Los Papas han presidido estas Misas enfatizando las llagas gloriosas de Jesús como fuente de paz y perdón.^{8 9 10}

La devoción popular en armonía con la liturgia

La Congregación para el Culto Divino enseña que la devoción a la Divina Misericordia, basada en los escritos de santa Faustina (canonizada en 2000), debe entenderse a la luz de las celebraciones litúrgicas pascuales, evitando separaciones.¹ Jesús le reveló a santa Faustina que la humanidad no hallará paz hasta volverse con confianza a la Divina Misericordia.²

Enseñanza papal: San Juan Pablo II la llamó "el don pascual que la Iglesia recibe del Cristo resucitado" para el tercer milenio.² Benedicto XVI la vio como la prenda de luz bautismal que ilumina la vida diaria.⁹ Francisco invita a ofrecer al Señor nuestras caídas para experimentar su misericordia, que supera toda miseria humana.¹⁰

Práctica recomendada: Participar en la liturgia con un corazón abierto al perdón, practicando la misericordia hacia los demás, como enseña Cristo: "Bienaventurados los misericordiosos, porque alcanzarán misericordia" (Mt 5,7).³ Esto reconstruye la fraternidad y la paz en familias y comunidades.¹¹

Llamado a la misericordia en la vida cotidiana

Los santos y las homilias papales exhortan a vivir esta fiesta extendiendo la misericordia: curando heridas ajenas, escuchando al sufriente y reconociendo en el prójimo las llagas de Cristo.^{3 10 12} "La misericordia pone fin al mal" y es la potencia divina de verdad y amor.⁹

Who can be a Godparent?

- **Must be a fully initiated Catholic (baptized, confirmed, and has received the Eucharist)**
- **At least 16 years old**
- **Practicing the faith and living in harmony with Church teachings**
- **Cannot be the child's parent**



Being a godparent is a **spiritual role**, not just a social one. The concept of godparents comes from the early Church, when adult converts were baptized and needed faithful Christians to help **guide** and **support** them in their new life with Christ. These sponsors were **witnesses** to the faith and stood beside the newly baptized as **spiritual mentors**. Today, especially in the case of infant baptism, the Church continues this tradition by inviting godparents to help nurture the child's faith as they grow. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

"Godparents... must be firm believers, able and ready to help the newly baptized — child or adult — on the road of Christian life." (CCC 1255)

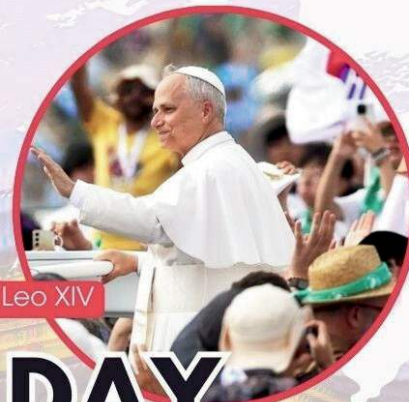
