SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

READING 1

ACTS 8:5-8, 14-17

Philip went down to the city of Samaria and proclaimed the Christ to them. With one accord, the crowds paid attention to what was said by Philip when they heard it and saw the signs he was doing.

For unclean spirits, crying out in a loud voice, came out of many possessed people, and many paralyzed or crippled people were cured. There was great joy in that city. Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who went down and prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, for it had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit.

“If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows him. READING 2

1 Peter 3:15-18

Beloved:

Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence, keeping your conscience clear, so that, when you are maligned, those who defame your good conduct in Christ may themselves be put to shame. For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that be the will of God, than for doing evil. For Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the Spirit.

Msgr. Tom's Musings: IT'S A WONDERFUL LIFE: THANKS BE TO GOD!

Wow! As we approach the May 15th anniversary of my 55 years of priesthood, I realize that 55 is more than a number; it's a large chunk of a lifetime poured out in priestly service to God and His people. That vocation began with a simple yet profound "yes" to Christ as I entered the seminary, and then later a "yes" to the Church, and a "yes" to a life that would no longer be my own, but would have to be given generously for others. Over these decades, that "yes" has echoed in countless ways through service in 3 dioceses: Detroit, Philly and Palm Beach. When I laid on that cold marble floor in the Cathedral-Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia on that beautiful Saturday morning, symbolizing an end to my wanderings through a previous life, I never realized that in rising, I would begin a new life that would pull me in so many different directions over the years because of that special call to serve. I continue to spend my life by serving in our parish with two fine priests: Fathers Leonard and Valentine.

I'm especially blessed to know and work among so many wonderful people at St. Matthew's. Over the years, standing at the altar, day after day, making present the greatest gift of all—the Eucharist, I came to realize that through my hands, generations would encounter Christ in Word and Sacrament. Having baptized countless infants, welcoming them into the family of God; witnessing several hundred exchanges of vows and blessed marriages, and helping build families rooted in faith; reconciling thousands of sinners, offering them God's mercy through moments of weakness and grace; commending many, many souls to God, standing with families in their deepest sorrow and reminding them of hope in eternal life — that's my "yes!"

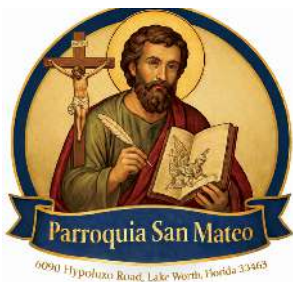
But beyond these sacred moments, the true impact of my or any other priest's life is found in the quiet, often unseen ways we shepherd God's people: the hospital visits no one else sees; the late-night calls answered without hesitation; homilies that strike a responsive chord just when someone needs it most. All of this is part of the steady presence of any priest who walks with his people through joys and struggles alike.

Fifty-five years of priesthood also means fifty-five years of perseverance through some difficult challenges, such as changes in the Church and the world, and moments that surely tested my faith. Yet through it all, I have tried to remain faithful—not perfect, but faithful—and that is what makes our priestly witness so powerful and so beautiful! I would gladly do it again!

God's surprising call to priesthood is not simply to a role or a profession—it's a relationship—a relationship with Christ the Good Shepherd, whose voice I have listened to and on whose love I have so often reflected; and I take consolation in this call, and because of it, countless lives may have been touched, guided, and strengthened. A priest's legacy is not written in books or buildings, but in people—in the hearts we have shaped, the faith we have nurtured, and the hope we have inspired. There are the many people whom I hope and pray are closer to God because of my "yes" to God's call.

As I celebrate this 55th anniversary, I also look with gratitude upon the many prayers and words of concern that are expressed by people like you who pray for, comfort and console us priests in our daily endeavors. May our ministry continue to bear fruit, reminding us that a vocation lived with love never truly ends—it only deepens. Today, I join my fellow priests as we say thank you! Thank you for your prayers, your kind words of encouragement, your thoughtful expressions of gratitude and your good example of trying to live a good Catholic-Christian life with your families. These make us feel that our sacrifices over many years of priesthood are worth it and have borne good fruit. God bless you for helping us to be the priests who strive to be good shepherds after the heart of Christ.

May God continue to abundantly bless and renew the call to be your priests, and fill us with the same joy that has sustained us over these years. May the Lord, who began this good work in us, bring it to it to fulfillment!
