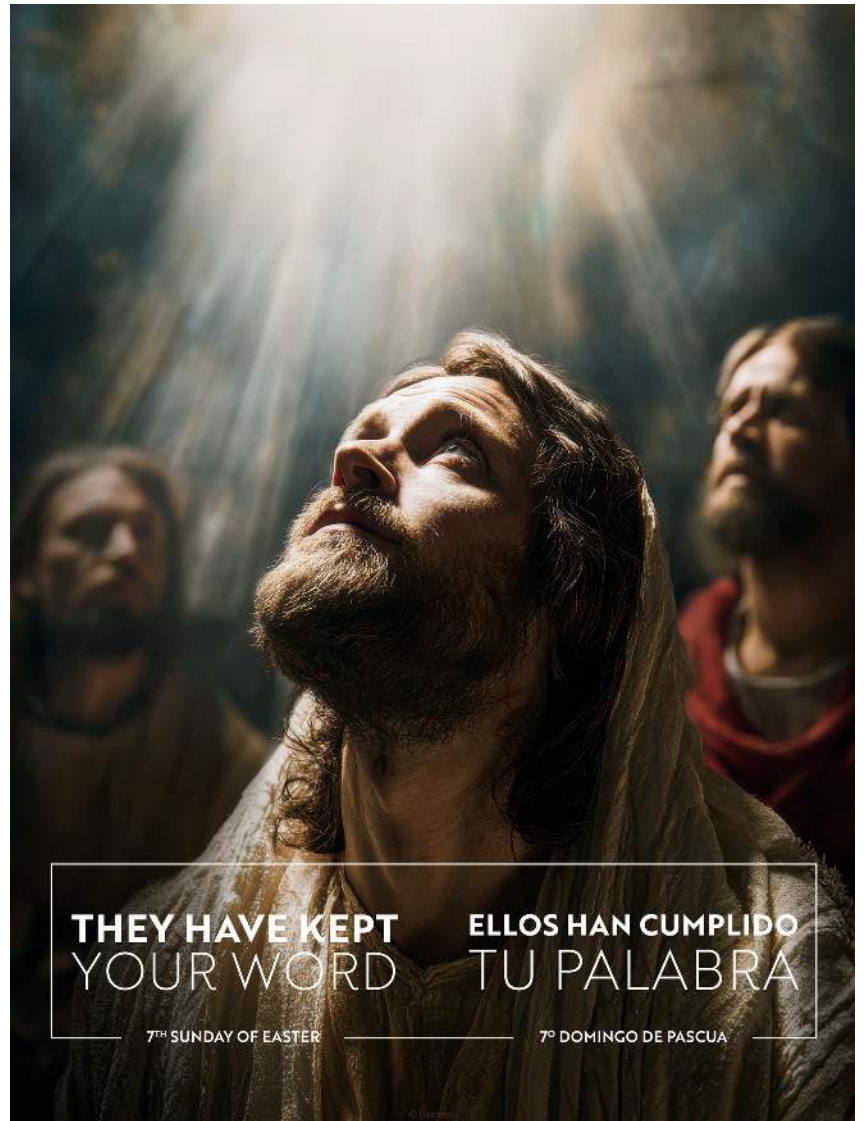

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD SUNDAY

Reading 1 Acts 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen.

He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.

While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them.

They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

Reading 2 Ephesians 1:17-23

Brothers and sisters:

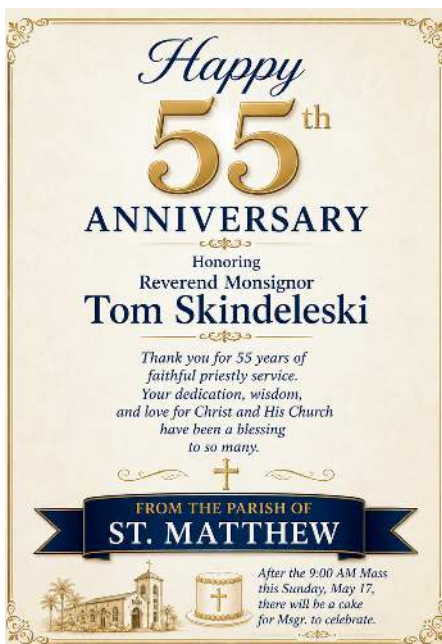
May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him. May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know what is the hope that belongs to his call, what are the riches of glory in his inheritance among the holy ones, and what is the surpassing greatness of his power

for us who believe, in accord with the exercise of his great might, which he worked in Christ, raising him from the dead and seating him at his right hand in the heavens, far above every principality, authority, power, and dominion, and every name that is named not only in this age but also in the one to come.

And he put all things beneath his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way.

Gospel Matthew 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.”



MSGR. TOM'S MUSINGS : CATHOLIC SCHOOL GRADUATION BLESSINGS

High school graduation is always a moment of joy. Diplomas are handed out, cameras flash, parents wipe away tears, and somewhere in the crowd there is always at least one person wondering how twelve years went by so quickly. For the graduates, it's a different question: "How did I get here already?"

For my part, volunteering as a Catholic Chaplain at St. John Paul II Academy is more a delight than work. Over 100 graduates this year are going out into the world of challenges. Some will be in college; others will find their place in specialty schools or in securing job opportunities in the marketplace. Being at their commencement exercises, knowing that I had a small part in getting them to the finish line of their high school careers is my joy.

Yet there's something deeper than academic success. We celebrate the blessing and privilege of graduating from a Catholic school, for a Catholic education is not simply about learning math, science, literature, or history—important as those are. A truly Catholic school forms the whole person: mind, heart, and soul. It teaches students not only how to make a living, but how to live. That's a great blessings they'll carry forth into their future.

Our grads learn from the witness of teachers, coaches, campus ministers, priests and parents, that faith is not something reserved for Sunday morning. Faith belongs in the classroom, on the athletic field, in service projects, and in daily life. Our students are reminded constantly that there's more than grades, awards, or college acceptance letters. In reality, they are sons and daughters of God. That truth may be the greatest lesson of all.

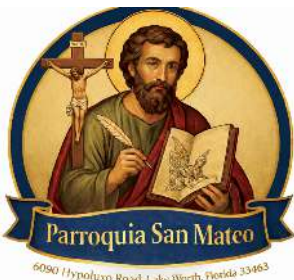
The world tells young people: "Your value comes from what you achieve." The Gospel says: "Your value comes from who you are in God's eyes." That changes everything, for in today's world, many people feel isolated and disconnected. But in a Catholic school, something like a family is created. They work together, stress out together before exams, celebrate victories together, and even survive cafeteria food together!

Another blessing of a Catholic education is learning the importance of service. They are taught that success is not measured by how high you climb, but by how many people you help along the way. Jesus never said, "They will know you are my disciples because you earned a high GPA." He said, "They will know you are my disciples by your love." Hopefully, that love has become part of who they are.

Years from now, graduates may forget some formulas and dates, but I hope they'll remember the people who walked beside them. Perhaps the greatest blessing of graduating from a Catholic school is this: they will leave knowing that God walks with them into the future. They've been given faith to guide them when life becomes confusing, and hope to sustain them when life becomes difficult. These are important values to anchor them when the world feels uncertain.

Wherever they go next, I hope they'll remember this: their diploma is not simply a sign that they completed something; it is also a commissioning. The Church and their school now send them into the world to be light, truth, compassion, and faith for others. The world doesn't need more successful people nearly as much as it needs good people: people

of integrity; people of mercy; people who remember the poor; people who forgive; people who stand for truth; people who keep faith alive. That is what Catholic education is about. The greatest thing they take with themselves from a Catholic school is not what was learned in their head, but what was planted in their heart. I congratulate all graduates. May God bless them always, and may the faith that formed them continue to guide them wherever life leads!

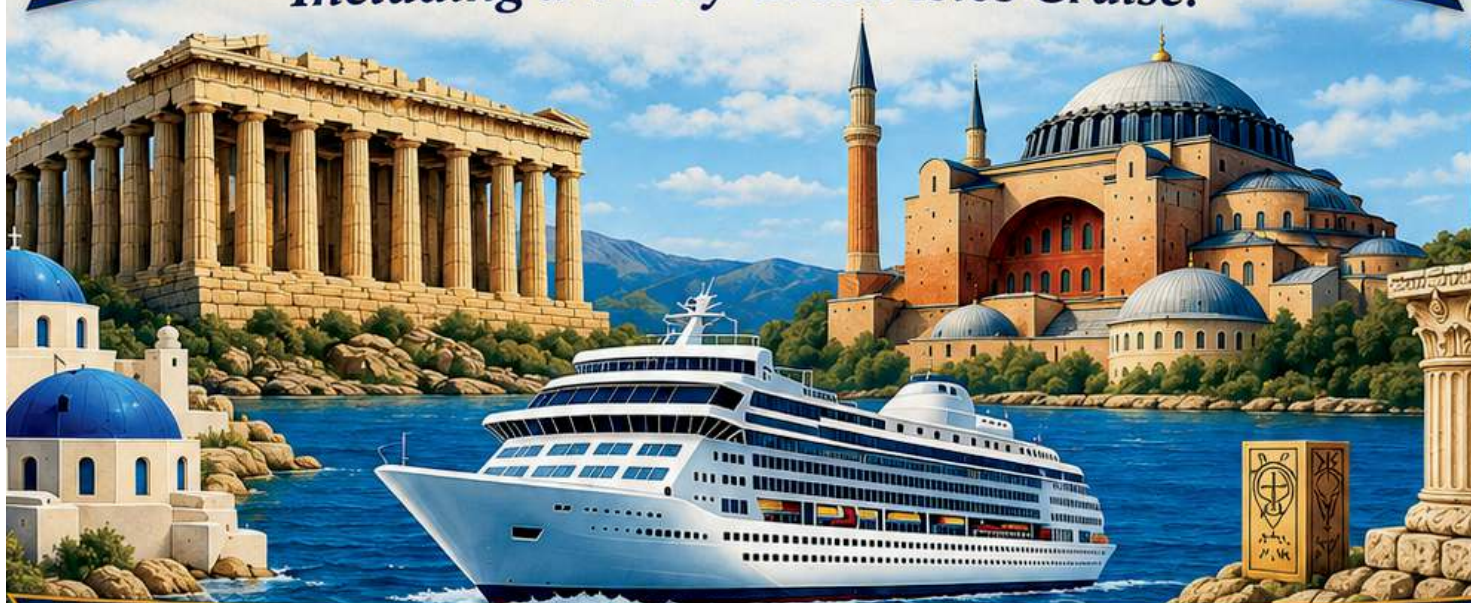
