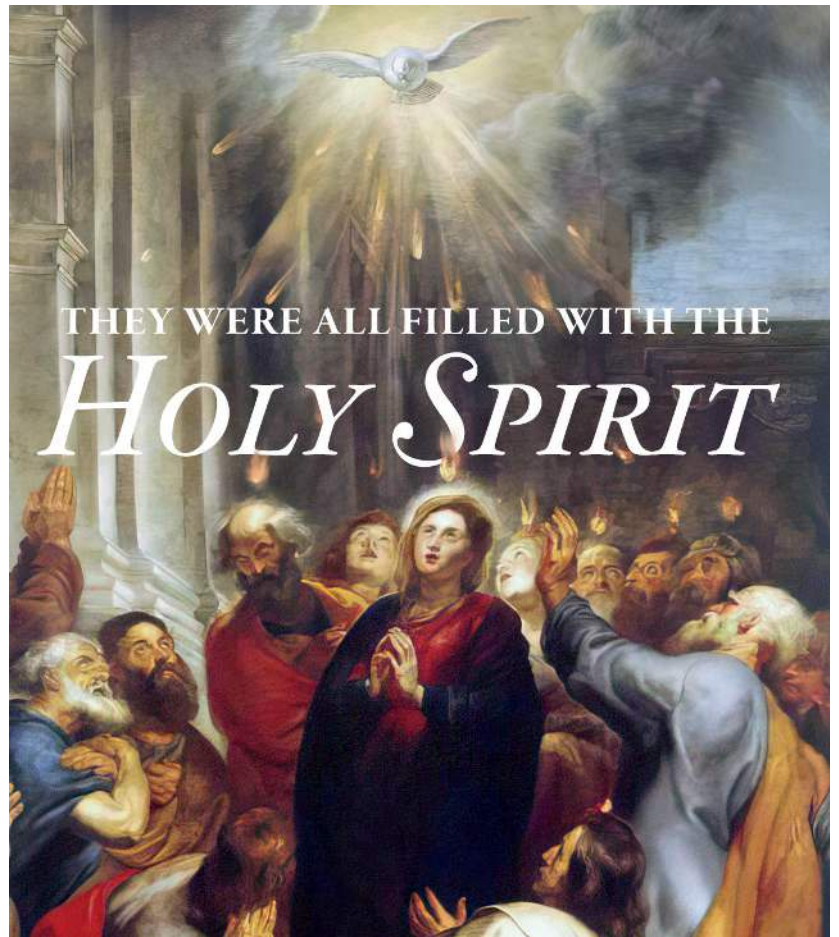

# THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

## **Reading 1** Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus,  
I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught  
until the day he was taken up,  
after giving instructions through the Holy  
Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen.  
He presented himself alive to them  
by many proofs after he had suffered,  
appearing to them during forty days  
and speaking about the kingdom of God.  
While meeting with them, he enjoined them  
not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for  
“the promise of the Father about which you  
have heard me speak; for John baptized with  
water, but in a few days you will be baptized  
with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered  
together they asked him, “Lord, are you at  
this time going to restore the kingdom to  
Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you  
to know the times or seasons that the Father  
has established by his own authority.  
But you will receive power when the Holy  
Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my  
witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea  
and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”  
When he had said this, as they were looking  
on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him  
from their sight. While they were looking  
intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly  
two men dressed in white garments stood  
beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee,  
why are you standing there looking at the  
sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from  
you into heaven will return in the same way as  
you have seen him going into heaven.”

## **Reading 2** Ephesians 1:17-23

Brothers and sisters:  
May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the  
Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom  
and revelation resulting in knowledge of him.  
May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened,  
that you may know what is the hope that  
belongs to his call, what are the riches of glory  
in his inheritance among the holy ones,  
and what is the surpassing greatness of his  
power for us who believe, in accord with the  
exercise of his great might, which he worked in  
Christ, raising him from the dead and seating  
him at his right hand in the heavens, far above  
every principality, authority, power, and  
dominion, and every name that is named  
not only in this age but also in the one to  
come. And he put all things beneath his feet  
and gave him as head over all things to the  
church, which is his body, the fullness of the  
one who fills all things in every way.

## **GOSPEL** Matthew 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the  
mountain to which Jesus had ordered  
them. When they saw him, they worshiped,  
but they doubted.  
Then Jesus approached and said to them,  
“All power in heaven and on earth has been  
given to me. Go, therefore, and make  
disciples of all nations,  
baptizing them in the name of the Father,  
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,  
teaching them to observe all that I have  
commanded you. And behold, I am with you  
always, until the end of the age.”

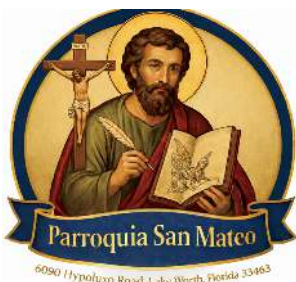



## Msgr. Tom's Musings: DO YOU HAVE LOCKED DOORS?

In the Gospel story from St. John for Pentecost Sunday, the disciples are hiding behind locked doors. They're afraid, confused, disappointed, and uncertain about the future. If we're honest, that scene shouldn't seem surprising for many people today, for there are locked doors everywhere. We lock our doors for security, safety and for protection from the unknown. When I was growing up in Philadelphia and its suburbs, we never locked our doors at night! That would be foolish today, but in those days, everyone seemed to watch out for their neighbor as well as for themselves. If we kids got into trouble, and our parents didn't learn about it directly from us, they often got a call from a neighbor who said something like, "Do you know what your son just did?"

But there are other kinds of doors that we lock, too. Some people lock their personal door because of anxiety about the future. Some lock that door because of fear of failure; or because of disappointment in relationships; or because they wonder whether they are good enough, successful enough, attractive enough, or holy enough. Some lock the door because they are exhausted from carrying pressure all the time: pressure to succeed; pressure to have a plan of action; pressure to appear happy; pressure to keep up with everyone else online.

The disciples had a similar kind of fear. They watched everything fall apart on Good Friday. The dreams they had for Jesus—and for themselves—seemed shattered; so they hid! But here's the beautiful part of the Gospel: Jesus doesn't wait for them to get it all together before He comes to them. The Gospel says: "Jesus came and stood in their midst." It wasn't after they became brave, or after they unlocked the doors, or after they figured out their future; He came while the doors were still locked, because that's how God works. Jesus enters the places we think are closed off—an anxious heart, a wounded memory, a confused mind, a guilty conscience—and He doesn't begin with anger or disappointment. He says, "Peace be with you," because peace is the first gift of the Resurrection.

Many young people today think they must hide their wounds: their mistakes, doubts, addictions, insecurities, failures, or struggles with faith. Social media teaches us to present a polished version of ourselves. But Jesus does the opposite. The glorified Christ reveals His wounds. Why? Because healed wounds become signs of hope. Our scars do not disqualify us from holiness. Sometimes they become the very place where God's mercy shines most clearly. This means our mission doesn't begin when we become perfect. It begins when we allow Christ to meet us where we are.

The teens, whose confessions I hear at St. John Paul II Academy, often ask: "What am I supposed to do with my life?" "What is my purpose?" "Where is God calling me?" Part of the answer is right here in this Gospel. We are sent to bring peace into a restless world. We are sent to bring hope into a cynical world. We are sent to bring mercy into a judgmental world. We are sent to bring light into places darkened by loneliness and despair - and we do it by the way we live. Every act of kindness matters; every word of encouragement matters; every time we defend someone who is left out, listen to someone who is hurting, forgive someone who wronged us, or choose integrity over popularity—we are living the mission of Christ. Christianity is not simply trying harder to be good. It is allowing the Holy Spirit to live within us. The same Spirit that transformed Peter into a courageous witness can transform us. The same Spirit that strengthened frightened disciples can strengthen us. The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead can open the locked doors in our life. Is there a locked door in your life Jesus wants to enter? Whatever it is, the risen Christ stands before you—not with condemnation, but with peace. He simply says to us what He said to the disciples: "Peace be with you!"
