Who was St. Charles L. Wanga and Companion, Martyrs? Feast day June 3rd

The Martyrs of Uganda remind Christians that persecution for faith continued even in modern times. In the 1880s, young Christian converts at King Mwanga's court in Uganda bravely defended their faith and protected other boys from the king's abusive behavior.

Joseph Mkasa, a Catholic leader at court, spoke against Mwanga's violence and was executed in 1885. After his death, Charles Lwanga continued leading the Christian community and protecting the young pages. In 1886, Mwanga ordered the execution of several young Christians after they refused to deny their faith.

The prisoners were marched to Namugongo for execution, showing remarkable courage and joy despite their suffering. Many forgave Mwanga and remained faithful until death, becoming honored as the Martyrs of Uganda.

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS TRULY GOD

—consubstantial with the Father and the Son—and is sent by the Father as the Spirit of the Son into the hearts of believers. **1**
In Catholic faith, the Holy Spirit was sent at Pentecost to continually sanctify the Church.

Through Christ, believers “have access in one Spirit to the Father.” The Spirit is also called the Spirit of life, dwelling in the Church and in the hearts of the faithful “as in a temple.”

Practically, the Holy Spirit guides the Church into all the truth, unifies believers, and equips the community with gifts and fruits for mission and holiness.

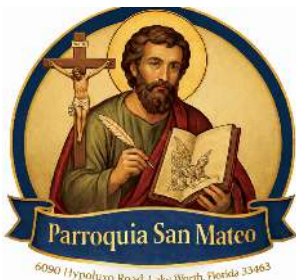

LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD

es el misterio central de la fe cristiana: Dios es uno solo, y a la vez se nos revela como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Creemos que no se trata de "tres dioses", sino de un solo Dios en tres Personas, sin confundir las Personas ni dividir la única esencia divina.

¿QUÉ SIGNIFICA "UN SOLO DIOS EN TRES PERSONAS"?

Significa que Dios es uno solo en su "ser" divino, y a la vez se nos revela como tres Personas reales: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. No son "tres dioses", porque el Dios que es Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo es el mismo Dios único.

La Iglesia lo resume así:

"No confundimos las Personas ni dividimos la sustancia":

"el Padre es una Persona, el Hijo otra, el Espíritu Santo otra;

pero la divinidad del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo es una sola."

En otras palabras:

Personas distintas (Padre, Hijo, Espíritu Santo).

Una sola realidad divina (la misma "esencia" o "sustancia" de Dios).

Es un misterio que solo conocemos porque Dios lo revela.

Msgr. Tom's Musings:

WHAT IS A CONFIRMED CATHOLIC —REALLY?

We're blessed this weekend to have our new BISHOP MANUEL de Jesus RODRIGUEZ to visit our parish again. The purpose of his visit this time is to confirm the Sacrament of Confirmation on a good number of our young people who have been preparing themselves to receive the great gift of the Holy Spirit in their lives. This Sacrament is one of the great gifts Christ gives to His Church. It's not simply a graduation from religious education or a ceremony marking maturity. Confirmation is our personal Pentecost. It's the moment when the Holy Spirit strengthens us with grace so that we can live our Catholic faith with courage, conviction, and joy.

When we were baptized, we became children of God. In Confirmation, those baptismal graces are deepened and strengthened. The Holy Spirit comes upon us in a powerful way, just as He came upon the Apostles in the Upper Room on the first Pentecost. Until that time, the Apostles were afraid; they hid behind locked doors. But after receiving the Holy Spirit, they became bold witnesses for Christ. That same Holy Spirit is given to every person who receives Confirmation. One of the beautiful aspects of Confirmation is that God doesn't leave us to live the Christian life alone. Sometimes people think faith is simply about trying harder or being morally good. But our Catholic Faith is more than human effort; it's divine help. Through Confirmation, God gives us a supernatural strength to live as disciples in a difficult world; and we need that strength today more than ever. Young people (and adults alike) face pressures, confusion, temptation, anxiety, and loneliness.

The world often tells us that faith should remain private, or is unimportant. Confirmation reminds us that we're called to stand confidently for Christ—not arrogantly, but lovingly. This Sacrament also gives us the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. These aren't abstract ideas; they're practical spiritual tools. Wisdom helps us to see life from God's perspective. Understanding deepens our grasp of the faith. Counsel helps us make good decisions. Fortitude gives courage during trials. Knowledge helps us recognize God's presence in the world. Piety draws us toward prayer and worship. Fear of the Lord (in the original sense of that expression) teaches reverence and awe before God.

These gifts shape our daily lives so that a confirmed Catholic will become more patient, more compassionate, more prayerful, and more willing to serve others. Another beauty of Confirmation is the connection it creates with the universal Church. During the sacrament, the bishop, or (in rare, exceptional cases) priest anoints the candidate with sacred chrism (a consecrated, special, and fragrant oil) and says, "Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit." That word "sealed" is important. In ancient times, a seal represented identity and belonging. Through Confirmation, we're marked as belonging completely to Christ.

The sacred oil, called chrism, itself is also significant. Throughout Scripture, oil symbolizes healing, strength, and consecration. Kings and prophets were anointed with oil. At Confirmation we're anointed for a mission: to bring Christ into the world. Yet, Confirmation is not the end of our faith formation; it's the beginning of mature discipleship. The Church needs confirmed Catholics who are active in their faith—not spectators, but participants. The world needs Catholics who pray, serve the poor, defend human dignity, and bring hope into families, schools, workplaces, and our communities, especially our parish community.

Perhaps one of the greatest benefits of Confirmation is this: we never walk alone. The Holy Spirit becomes our guide, comforter, and advocate. In moments of fear, He gives courage. In moments of confusion, He gives wisdom. In moments of weakness, He gives strength. Confirmation is ultimately about relationship—a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church. It is God saying to us: "I am with you. I will strengthen you. I am calling you to greatness." When we embrace that gift, our faith becomes more than something we merely practice on Sundays; it becomes the foundation of our lives.

May our newly confirmed Catholics open their hearts daily to the Holy Spirit and live as joyful witnesses of Christ in the world. Congratulations to our future saints!!
