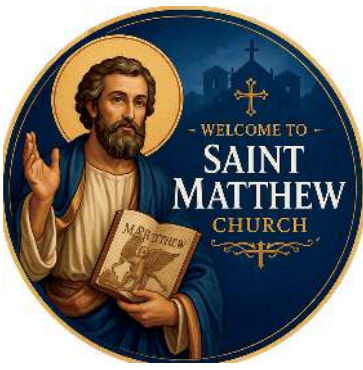

I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.

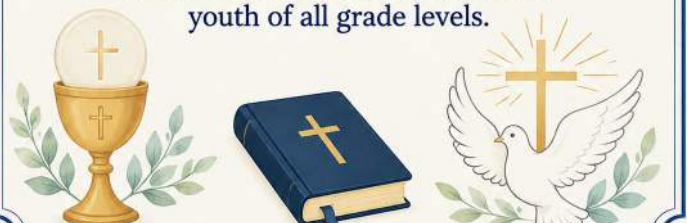

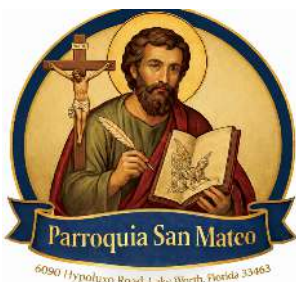

Msgr. Tom's Musings: AND WHAT DO WE CATHOLICS TAKE PRIDE IN?

If you ask different Americans, “To what is the month of June dedicated?”, you could not get two more diverse responses than: **PRIDE MONTH** (meaning Gay Pride - from the secular point of view) or **THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS** (from devout Catholics).

The first one is commemorated in various entertainment establishments such as Disney World; the second was made most manifest last week by the American bishops in the Basilica-Shrine of Queen of the Universe (almost ironically, also in Orlando, just a few short miles away). There, America's Catholic bishops gathered and consecrated the Church In America, as well as all of America, to the most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This was a most important act, considering we are celebrating the 250th anniversary of the founding of our country.

During the Mass there, Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore, who is also the Supreme Chaplain for the Knights of Columbus, delivered a beautiful homily in conjunction with the consecration to the Sacred Heart. Because of the length of the homily, I will divide it in half, and share it with you this week, and the conclusion in next week's Musings. (I did a very limited editing of the homily for the sake of brevity).

“[What a remarkable moment of grace we are privileged to share. On the threshold of our nation's 250th anniversary, we gather not first to celebrate ourselves, but to consecrate, to entrust, to place the Church in the United States—and, indeed, to place our whole nation—into the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ. Why do we do this? Because consecration is an act of **FAITH**. It's an acknowledgement that history is not simply the story of what human beings can accomplish.

It is the story of God's faithful love at work in the world.

We give thanks for the blessings of these past 250 years, but we do so with a humble faith, recognizing that every nation stands in need of God's mercy, wisdom, and guidance. We consecrate our nation, not because it is perfect, but because it is beloved by God. We entrust to the heart of Christ our achievements and our failures, our hopes and our anxieties, our present challenges and our future aspirations. We ask him to heal what is working, strengthen what is good, and guide us towards the future guided by justice, peace, freedom, and respect for the dignity of every human person—especially the unborn, the immigrant, the poor, and the vulnerable.

Consecration is also an act of **HOPE**. It is a declaration that the future does not belong merely to political movements, economic forces, or human plans. The future belongs to God. And so we place into His heart, not only ourselves, but generations yet unborn—all those who will inherit the Church and the nation we leave behind.

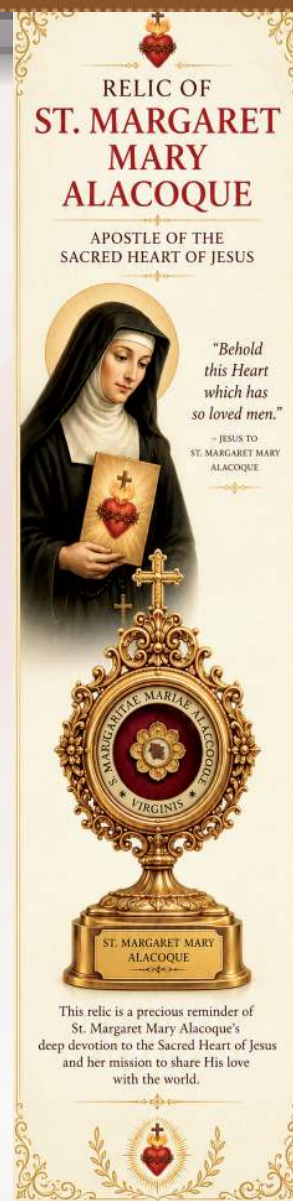
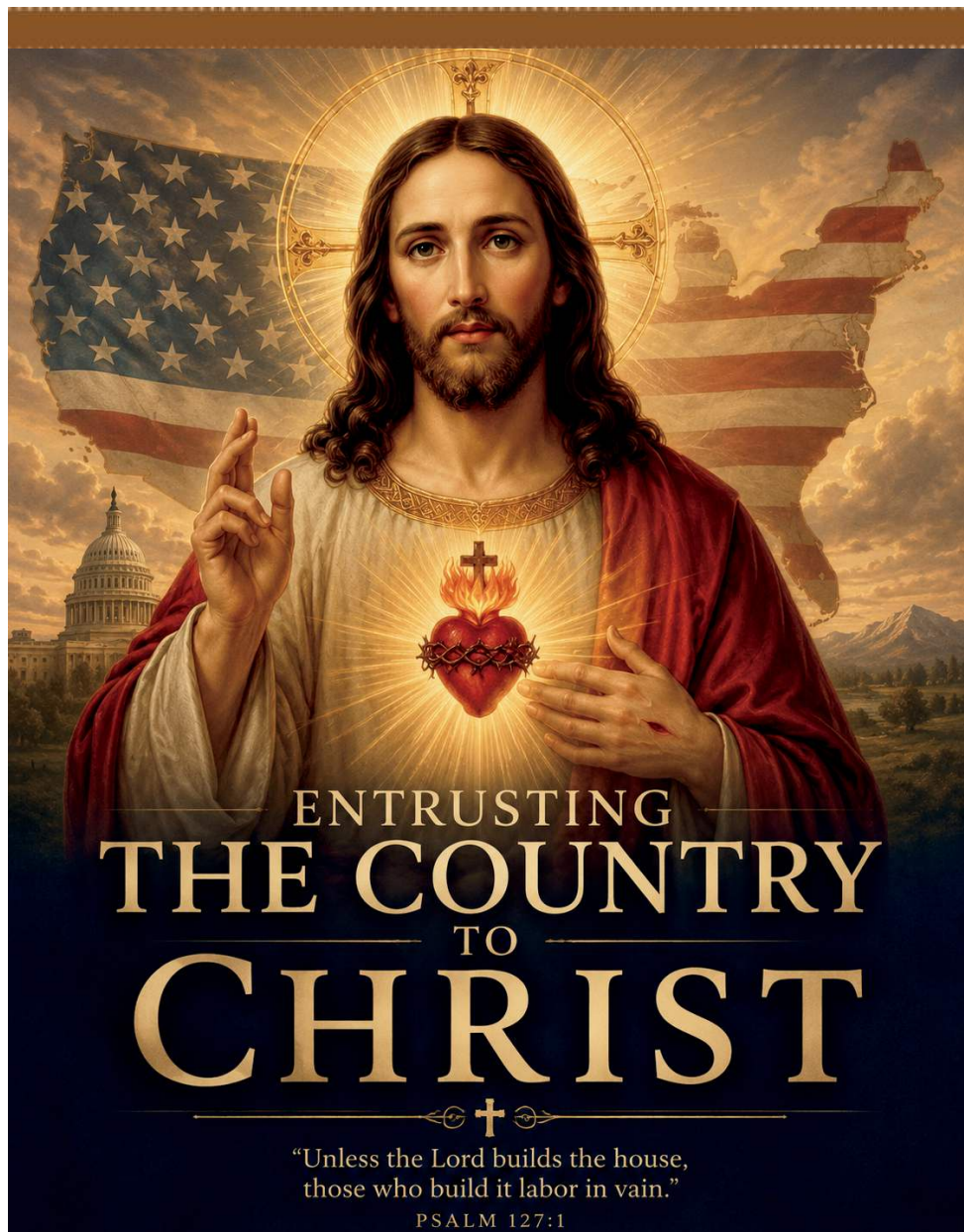
In a culture that prizes independence and self-reliance, we gather publicly to acknowledge that our deepest identity and our truest hope come not from ourselves but from the Lord. Jesus says, “As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love.” The Sacred Heart is the visible sign of that **LOVE**. It is not an abstract devotion. It is a revelation of God's love in the flesh, a heart that has known joy and sorrow, friendship and betrayal, suffering and sacrifice.

Jesus tells us something else that is extraordinary. He says, “I have called you friends.” The Sacred Heart reveals a Savior who desires not merely our obedience, but our friendship; not simply our service, but our communion with Him.]” (end of part 1)

U.S. bishops consecrate nation to Sacred Heart of Jesus

On June 11, 2026, U.S. bishops held a consecration Mass at the Basilica of the National Shrine of Mary, Queen of the Universe in Orlando, entrusting the nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The ceremony was part of the bishops' spring plenary assembly and coincided with the United States' 250th anniversary. Archbishop William E. Lori delivered the homily, emphasizing entrusting the country to Christ's love rather than celebrating the bishops themselves. Pre-Mass reflections highlighted how devotion to the Sacred Heart addresses modern spiritual challenges such as loneliness, identity crises, and the need for community. Bishops also spent time in Eucharistic adoration, benediction, and venerated relics of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque before the Mass.

We invite every household to prayerfully consider how you can participate. Please take a donation card, pray over your gift, and return it in the offertory, to the parish office, or online.

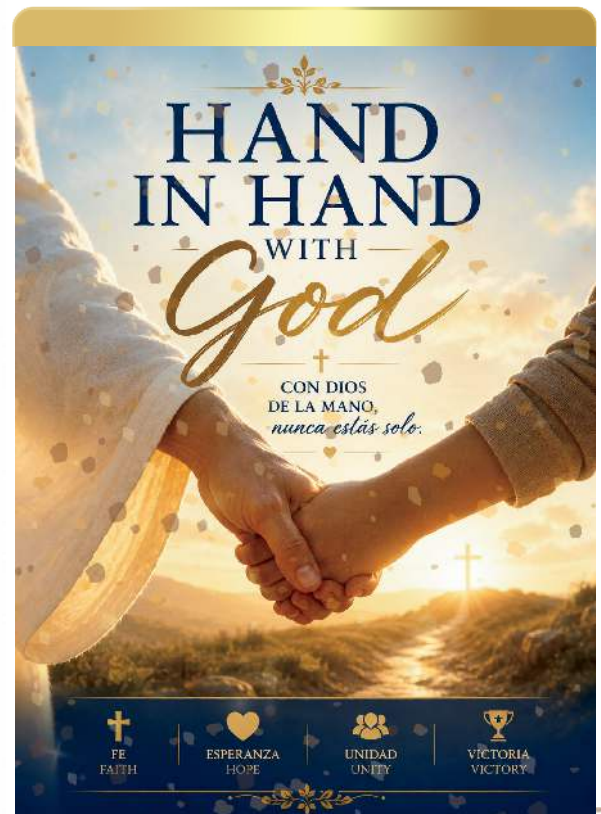
