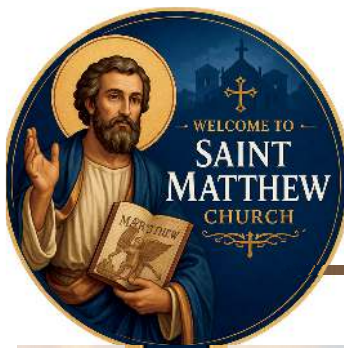

Gospel

Matthew 14:13-21

When Jesus heard of the death of John the Baptist, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself. The crowds heard of this and followed him on foot from their towns. When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, and he cured their sick. When it was evening, the disciples approached him and said, "This is a deserted place and it is already late; dismiss the crowds so that they can go to the villages and buy food for themselves." Jesus said to them, "There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves." But they said to him, "Five loaves and two fish are all we have here." Then he said, "Bring them here to me," and he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing, broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, who in turn gave them to the crowds. They all ate and were satisfied, and they picked up the fragments left over—twelve wicker baskets full. Those who ate were about five thousand men, not counting women and children.

*Our Hope
in Christ*

During the past few weeks, several beloved elderly members of our parish family have passed from this life. We extend our heartfelt condolences to their families and friends. We share in your sorrow, and we accompany you with our prayers.

Grief is painful because love is real. Jesus Himself wept at the death of His friend Lazarus. Yet He also gave us this promise: “I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live.” Our Catholic faith does not teach us to ignore the pain of death; it teaches us to face it with hope in the risen Christ.

The Church reminds us that, for a Christian, life is changed—not ended. Through His Death and Resurrection, Jesus conquered the power of death and opened the way to eternal life. We believe that those who die in God’s friendship are called to live with Him and that, on the last day, Christ will raise the faithful to new life. Catechism of the Catholic Church, 988–991

Our love and responsibility for those who have died do not end at the grave. From the earliest days of Christianity, the Church has prayed for the faithful departed. Above all, she offers the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for them, asking God to forgive their sins, complete their purification, and welcome them into the joy of heaven. Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1030–1032

Having a Mass celebrated for someone who has died is one of the most loving spiritual gifts we can offer. At every Mass, Christ’s saving sacrifice is made present, and the whole Church—on earth, in heaven, and awaiting complete purification—is united in prayer.

To our grieving families: you are not alone. Your parish family remembers your loved ones and walks beside you. May Christ, who died and rose for us, console your hearts and strengthen your hope until the day when we are reunited in God’s eternal presence.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

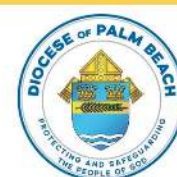

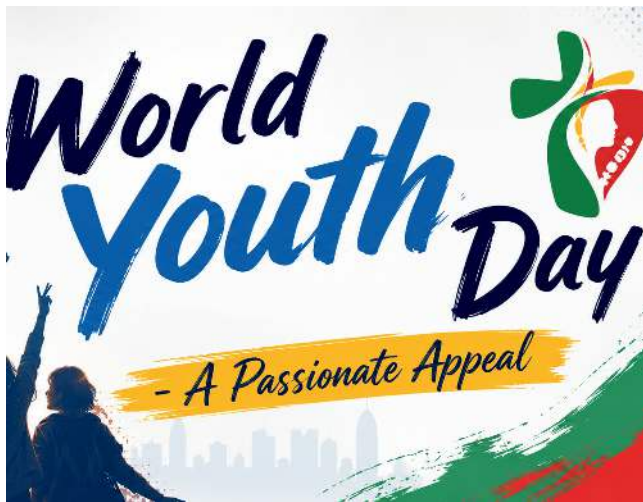
