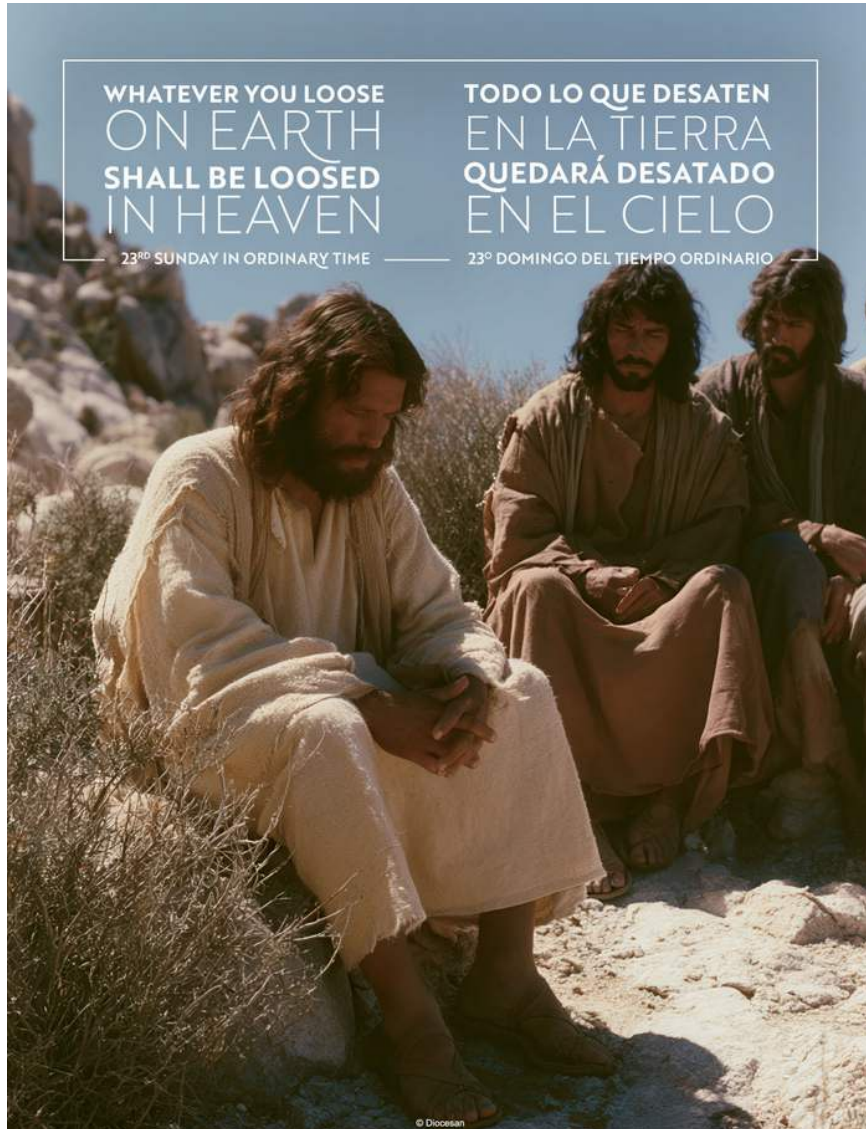

Brothers and sisters:

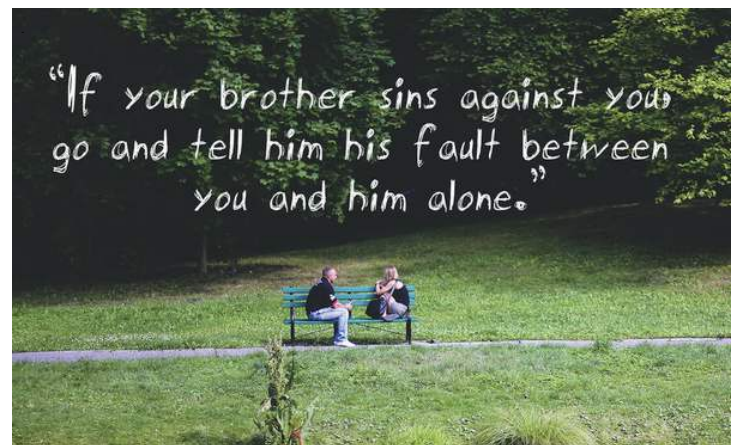
Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.

If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector. Amen, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

## Notre Dame & the French Revolution

During this month of September, our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, will be making his first official visit as pope to France. He will visit three cities with special religious significance: Lourdes, with its holy and beautiful Marian grotto, Metz, with the Cathedral of St. Stephen and its exquisite stained glass, and Paris, including the famous Notre Dame Cathedral. This last stop is at one of France's most powerful religious, architectural and cultural gems. We remember televised images of Notre Dame aflame in mid-April 2019. It evoked questions about how the city and the cathedral could ever move forward. Yet, that fire isn't the first time the cathedral has faced possible destruction.

During the French Revolution in the 1790s, angry mobs and revolutionaries looted the beautiful Gothic church—and even declared that it wasn't a church at all—during a bloody push to remove France's close ties to the Catholic Church. Many images affixed to the church facade were publicly decapitated the same year as was their king and his Austrian-born Queen Marie Antoinette.

Up to the storming of the Bastille by the revolutionaries in Paris in 1789, the Church wielded great power in France. The vast majority of French people were Catholic, Catholicism was the state religion, and the Church was intimately tied in with the French nobility. But a growing number of French people had tired of the Church's influence and association with royal power,

As the monarchy fell, a small group of radicals, who had been influenced by Enlightenment-era philosophies, saw their chance to strip the Church of much of its authority. They embarked on a devastating anti-Catholic campaign, confiscating Church property, trying to get all clergy to swear their loyalty to the new state, and removing the Church's control over administrative records it had held for so long.

As the Revolution gained steam, so did its attempts to strip the Catholic Church of its role in French life. Parisians arrested, jailed and executed priests and religious women during the September Massacres of 1792, and the Reign of Terror that followed. In 1793, the new government announced that public worship was illegal, so people rushed into churches, stripping them of religious symbols.

Notre Dame had long been a symbol of the monarchy, too, and its west facade featured 28 statues that portrayed the biblical Kings of Judah. In the fall of 1793, the new government ordered workers to remove them. Though they didn't portray French kings, that didn't matter. The 500-year-old statues combined monarchy and religion, so they were decapitated. Twenty-one of the heads were only recovered in 1977, when workers found them behind a wall of an old Parisian mansion.

That wasn't the end of turmoil involving the cathedral. In November 1793, it became the site of a revolutionary and anti-religious festival that both mocked Catholicism and suggested that French people should worship Enlightenment principles instead.

After the cathedral was plundered, it became the stage for pagan-styled events, including a seductively dressed actress portraying the Goddess of Reason lying on the main altar. The venerable cathedral became the Temple of Reason, and almost everything inside was looted.

Eventually, dechristianization efforts extended throughout all France, instituting a new, atheist state "religion" devoted to revolution.

Despite all those attempts to stamp out Catholicism for good, many French people stuck to their religious beliefs. Many faithful parents refused to send their children to be instructed in the new civic religion, and attendance for civil events and government festivals was chronically low. Catholicism proved to be the stabilizing element that many segments of society could cling to amidst the storm of upheaval and change that was the French Revolution."

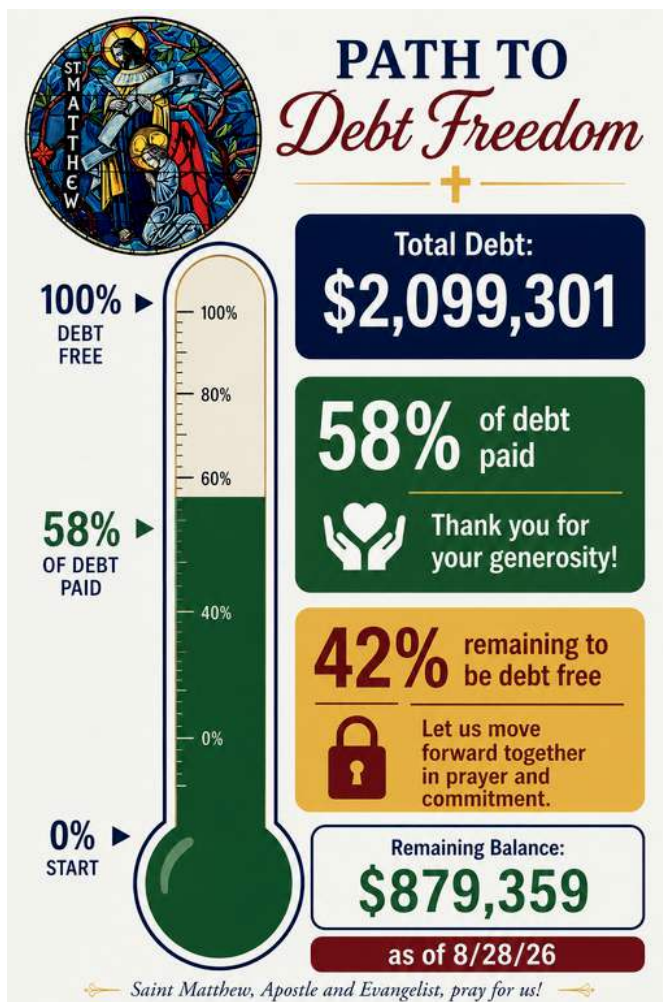

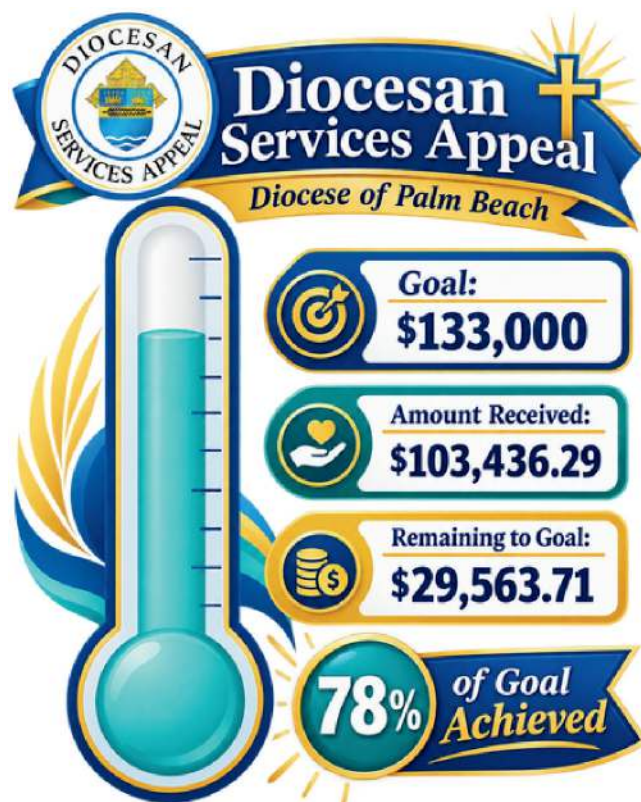
