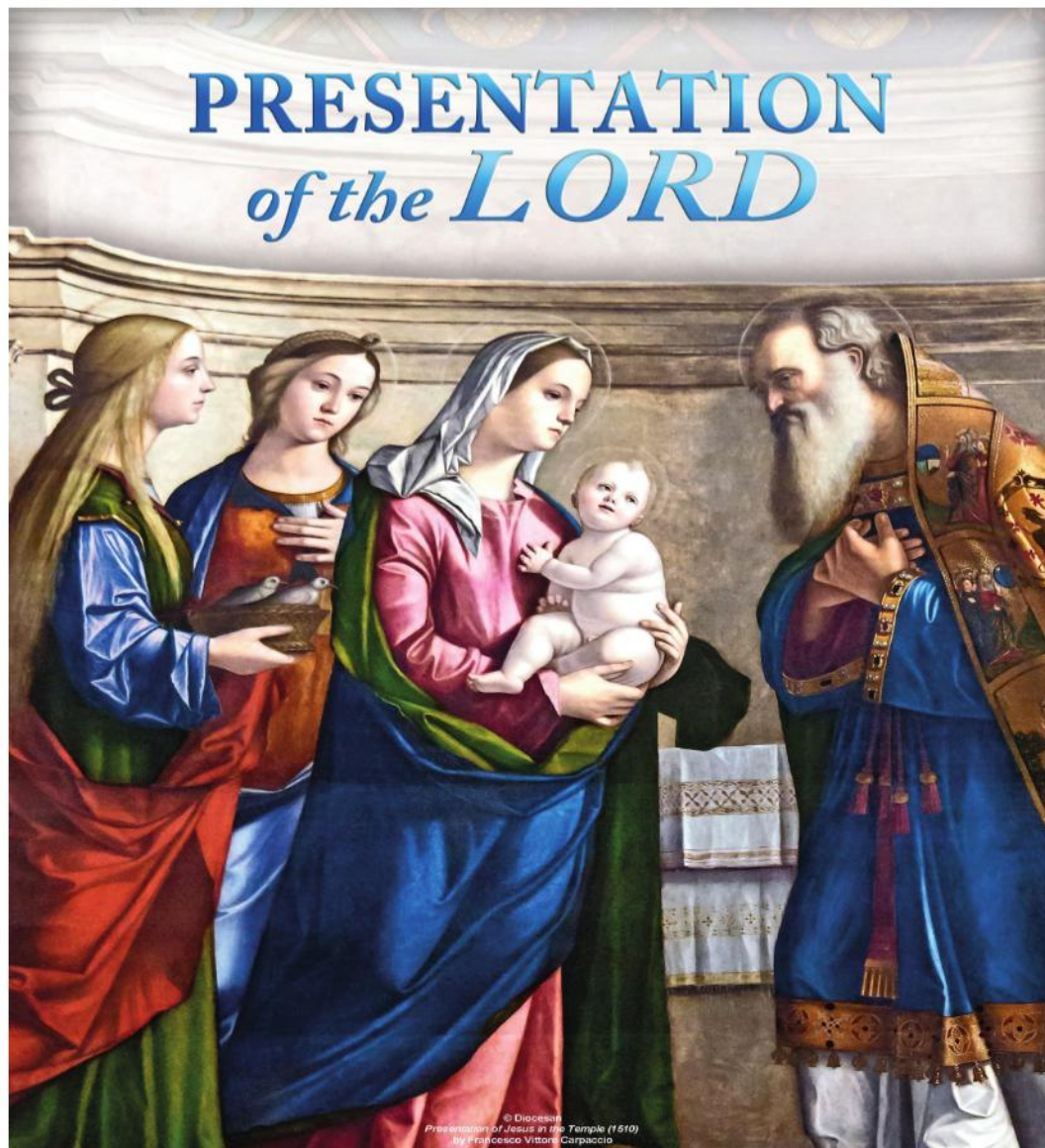

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Lectionary: 524

Reading I

Malachi 3:1-4

Thus says the Lord GOD: Lo, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me; And suddenly there will come to the temple the LORD whom you seek, And the messenger of the covenant whom you desire. Yes, he is coming, says the LORD of hosts. But who will endure the day of his coming? And who can stand when he appears? For he is like the refiner's fire, or like the fuller's lye. He will sit refining and purifying silver, and he will purify the sons of Levi, refining them like gold or like silver that they may offer due sacrifice to the LORD. Then the sacrifice of Judah and Jerusalem will please the LORD, as in the days of old, as in years gone by.

Reading II

Hebrews 2:14-18

Since the children share in blood and flesh, Jesus likewise shared in them, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the Devil, and free those who through fear of death had been subject to slavery all their life. Surely he did not help angels but rather the descendants of Abraham; therefore, he had to become like his brothers and sisters in every way, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest before God to expiate the sins of the people. Because he himself was tested through what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested.

Gospel

Luke 2:22-40 or 2:22-32

When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, *Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord*, and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, in accordance with the dictate in the law of the Lord.

Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. He came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him, he took him into his arms and blessed God, saying: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

The child's father and mother were amazed at what was said about him; and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted -and you yourself a sword will pierce- so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived seven years with her husband after her marriage, and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer. And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem.

When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth.

The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.

CAMINANDO CON LA
PALABRA

2 de febrero de 2025

Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor

(Malaquías 3, 1-4; Salmo 23, 7. 8. 9. 10; Hebreos 2, 14-18; Lucas 2, 22-40)

Hacemos un breve paréntesis dentro del tiempo ordinario para conmemorar la gran *Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor*. En muchos de nuestros países esta celebración se

conoce con el nombre de *La Candelaria*, observada típicamente con un matiz bien mariano, pues nuestra Santa Madre es una protagonista importante del episodio del Evangelio de San Lucas que la liturgia expone hoy.

Detengámonos a contemplar la escena y consideremos a Simeón, descubriendo qué rasgos en él pueden servirnos de guía en nuestro propio camino espiritual. Relata San Lucas que el anciano era un "varón justo y temeroso de Dios, que aguardaba el consuelo de Israel; en él moraba el Espíritu Santo." Esto implica que Simeón vivía en estado de Gracia, lo cual le permitió conocer y entender que "no moriría sin haber visto antes al Mesías del Señor." Estaba en atenta escucha de lo que le comunicaba Dios y esto ciertamente lo llevaba a vivir una fe esperanzada en la promesa de Yahvé. Obediente a la acción del Espíritu en su alma, se adelantó al templo cuando la Sagrada Familia llegaba y pudo reconocer en el Niño al Salvador, la "luz que alumbraba a las naciones y gloria de tu pueblo Israel."

¿Cómo podemos percatarnos, a la manera de Simeón, cuándo Cristo pasa frente a nosotros? Primero, debemos frecuentar el sacramento de la Reconciliación, pues en Gracia nuestra alma estará más pronta a escuchar y comprender la voz del Espíritu Santo quien nos apunta a Jesús. Igualmente, el llevar una disciplina de oración comprometida alimentará nuestra fe y nos facilitará el discernimiento para obedecer las inspiraciones que ese mismo Espíritu desea transmitirnos. En adición, no pasemos por alto los incontables beneficios para nuestra vida espiritual de la recepción frecuente de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Llenos de confianza, centrados en las promesas de Dios, proclamaremos entonces ante el mundo que nuestros ojos "han visto a tu Salvador, al que has preparado para bien de todos los pueblos" y daremos testimonio de Él.

Why do Catholics celebrate the Feast of the Presentation?

This feast day celebrates both the
Presentation of Jesus in the Temple and the
Purification of Mary, which was required by
the Mosaic Law 40 days after the birth of a
child. The Church celebrates the Feast of
the Presentation of the Lord on February 2,
also called Candlemas for the custom of
using lighted candles. In the early Church, it
was often celebrated on February 14, 40
days after the Epiphany, in keeping with the
practice of celebrating Christmas on that
date in the East. Among the Orthodox, it is
known as the Hypapante ("Meeting" of the
Lord with Simeon). Article from EWTN
