## Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Lectionary: 84

### Reading I

Sirach 27:4-7

When a sieve is shaken, the husks appear;  
so do one's faults when one speaks.

As the test of what the potter molds is in the furnace, so in tribulation is the test of the just. The fruit of a tree shows the care it has had; so too does one's speech disclose the bent of one's mind.

Praise no one before he speaks, for it is then that people are tested.

### Reading II

1 Corinthians 15:54-58

Brothers and sisters: When this which is corruptible clothes itself with incorruptibility and this which is mortal clothes itself with immortality, then the word that is written shall come about:

*Death is swallowed up in victory.  
There, O death, is your victory?  
Where, O death, is your sting?*

The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God who gives us the Victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be firm, steadfast, always fully devoted to the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

## Gospel

Luke 6:39-45

Jesus told his disciples a parable, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher.

Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,' when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye? You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye.

"A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its own fruit. For people do not pick figs from thornbushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles. A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks."

Octavo domingo ordinario

(Sirácide 27, 5-8 ; Del Salmo 91; 1 Corintios 15, 54-58; Lucas 6, 39-45)

La liturgia de este domingo invita a un examen de conciencia inicial en preparación a la Cuaresma que comenzaremos en solamente unos días. Ser discípulo fiel del Maestro conlleva vivir con rectitud de intención y un constante análisis de la condición de nuestra alma.

Las lecturas apuntan a una imagen de la vida espiritual como una planta cuyo estado, en última instancia, se da a conocer por la calidad de los frutos que produce. El libro del Sirácide (Eclesiástico) declara que “el fruto muestra cómo ha sido el cultivo de un árbol” (cf Sir 27, 6), mientras que el salmo 91 dice de los justos que estos “seguirán dando fruto en su vejez, frondosos y lozanos como jóvenes” (cf Sal 91, 15). Jesucristo, muy dado al empleo de metáforas agrícolas, apunta en adición que “cada árbol se conoce por sus frutos: no se recogen higos de las zarzas, ni se cortan uvas de los espinos” (cf Luc 6, 44).

La fe de los primeros cristianos fue dando impactantes frutos de conversiones al Evangelio dentro del mundo antiguo. A pesar del sufrimiento, el acoso y la persecución, llegando tantas veces al martirio, el testimonio de esos fieles llevó a la diseminación de la Buena Nueva a los confines de la tierra. Nosotros, la Iglesia del siglo XXI, tenemos ese mismo llamado dentro de una sociedad que necesita apremiantemente el mensaje de Cristo.

Durante estas próximas semanas del tiempo fuerte cuaresmal, dediquémonos a discernir cómo estamos llamados a ser, en nuestra familia y en nuestra comunidad, esos “cedros en los altos montes, plantados en la casa del Señor, que en medio de sus atrios darán flores” (cf. Sal 91, 14). Que Santa María, Madre del buen consejo y Refugio de los pecadores, nos acompañe en el caminar hacia la Pascua de su Hijo.
