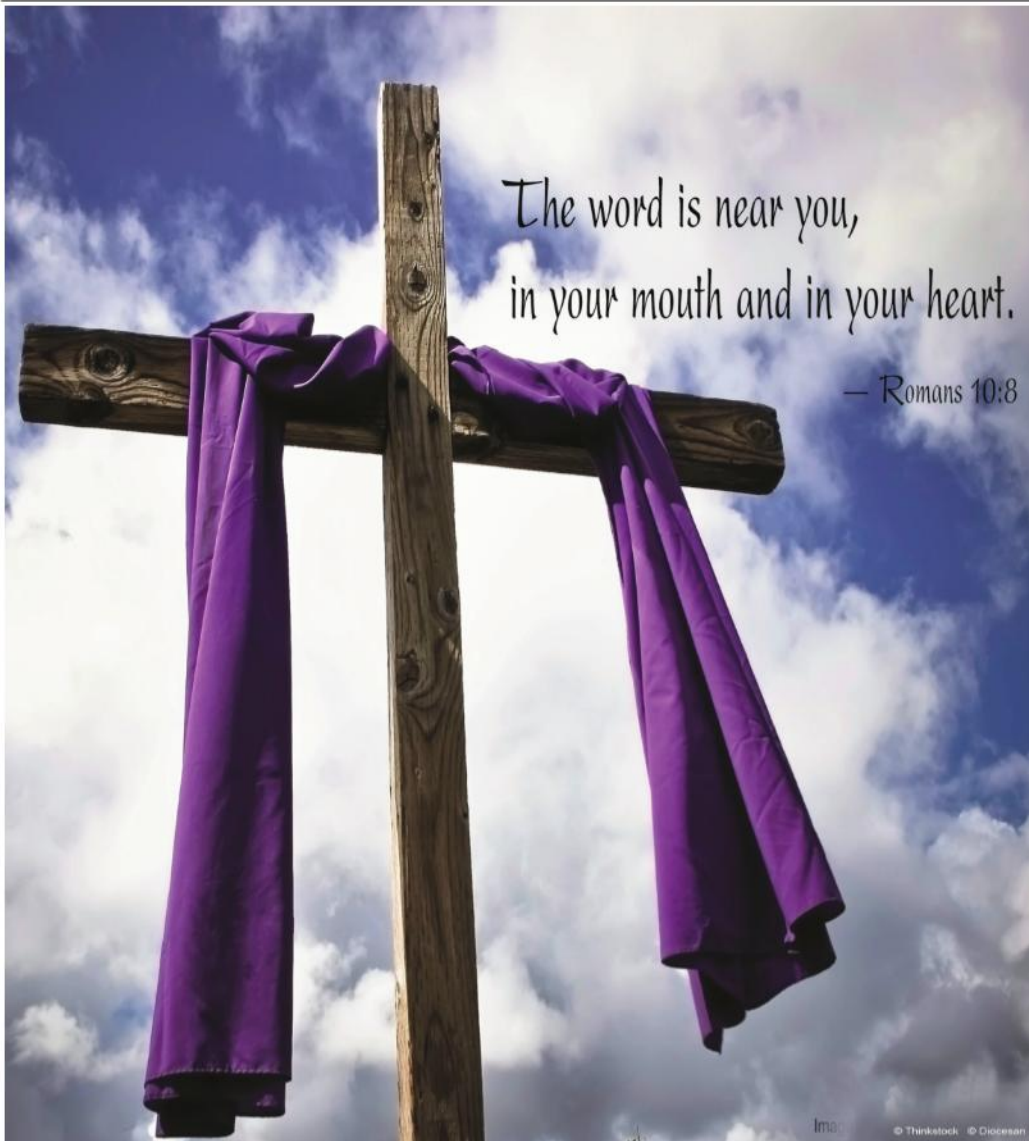

## First Sunday of Lent

Lectionary: 24

Reading I

### Deuteronomy 26:4-10

Moses spoke to the people, saying: "The priest shall receive the basket from you and shall set it in front of the altar of the LORD, your God.

Then you shall declare before the Lord, your God, 'My father was a wandering Aramean who went down to Egypt with a small household and lived there as an alien.

But there he became a nation great, strong, and numerous. When the Egyptians maltreated and oppressed us, imposing hard labor upon us, we cried to the LORD, the God of our fathers, and he heard our cry and saw our affliction, our toil, and our oppression.

He brought us out of Egypt with his strong hand and outstretched arm, with terrifying power, with signs and wonders; and bringing us into this country, he gave us this land flowing with milk and honey. Therefore, I have now brought you the first fruits of the products of the soil which you, O LORD, have given me.'

And having set them before the LORD, your God, you shall bow down in his presence."

Reading II

### Romans 10:8-13

Brothers and sisters: What does Scripture say? *The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart*—that is, the word of faith that we preach—for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved. For the Scripture says, *No one who believes in him will be put to shame.*

For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all, enriching all who call upon him.

For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

### Luke 4:1-13

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil.

He ate nothing during those days, and when they were over he was hungry.

The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread."

Jesus answered him, "It is written, *One does not live on bread alone.*" Then he took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a single instant.

The devil said to him, "I shall give to you all this power and glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I may give it to whomever I wish.

All this will be yours, if you worship me."

Jesus said to him in reply, "It is written *You shall worship the Lord, your God, and him alone shall you serve.*"

Then he led him to Jerusalem, made him stand on the parapet of the temple, and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, for it is written: *He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you, And their hands they will support you, lest you dash your foot against a stone.*"

Jesus said to him in reply, "It also says,

*You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test.*"

When the devil had finished every temptation, he departed from him for a time.

Primer domingo de Cuaresma

(Deuteronomio 26, 4-10; Salmo 90, 1-2. 10-11. 12-13. 14-15; Romanos 10, 8-13; Lucas 4, 1-13)

En los inicios del tiempo fuerte de Cuaresma, al Iglesia presenta selecciones de las Sagradas Escrituras que nos ayudan a enmarcar la marcha hacia la Pascua, especialmente inspirándonos a reconocer que el Señor nos acompaña en ese caminar.

Nos es tan familiar el episodio de las tentaciones de Jesús en el desierto que éste puede parecernos como algo ajeno y distante a nuestra vida diaria. Argumentaríamos que Cristo, por ser verdadero Dios, naturalmente iba a salir victorioso de las acechanzas del diablo. Tengamos en cuenta, sin embargo, que Jesús es también verdadero hombre, y que las incitaciones diabólicas a las que fue sometido las sufrió precisamente en su humanidad.

¿Cómo podemos nosotros, a la manera de Jesucristo, ser también vencedores a pesar de los ataques del enemigo que se presentan? El bello himno de esperanza en el Señor que se medita en el salmo 90 nos da la clave. “Tú que vives al amparo del Altísimo y descansas a la sombra del Todopoderoso, dile al Señor: ‘Tú eres mi refugio y fortaleza; tú eres mi Dios y en ti confío’” (cf. sal 90, 1). El salmista declara que la protección divina nos está garantizada. Los ángeles mismos evitarán que nos tropecemos irremediabilmente con las piedras de la tentación, “porque Él les ha ordenado que te protejan en todos tus caminos” (cf. sal 90, 11).

Supliquemos pues durante esta Cuaresma al Espíritu Santo, para que afiance en nosotros la virtud de la esperanza. En toda tribulación, especialmente en las tentaciones que se nos presenten, recordemos que contamos con la ayuda de su Gracia. Apuntaba el Papa Benedicto XVI, “un lugar primero y esencial de aprendizaje de la esperanza es la oración. Cuando ya nadie me escucha, Dios todavía me escucha. Cuando ya no puedo hablar con ninguno, ni invocar a nadie, siempre puedo hablar con Dios. Si ya no hay nadie que pueda ayudarme –cuando se trata de una necesidad o de una expectativa que supera la capacidad humana de esperar–, Él puede ayudarme” (cf. Carta Encíclica *Spe Salvi*, 32).
