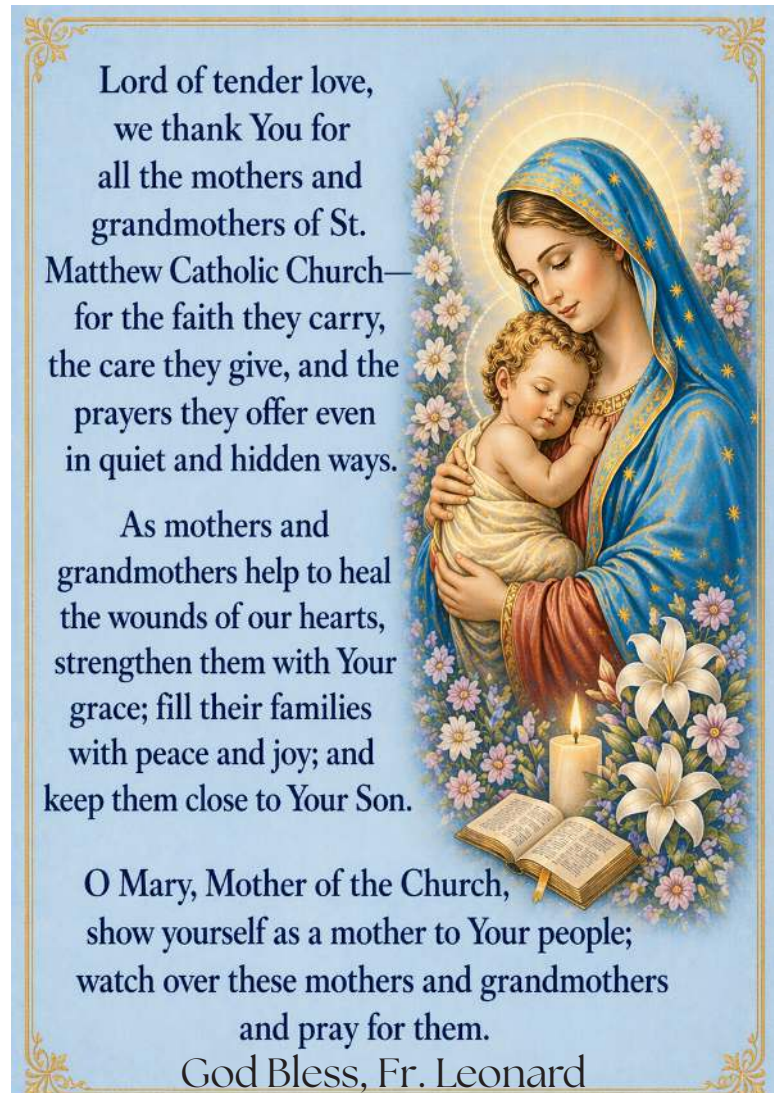

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Lectionary: 52 Reading 1

Acts 6:1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

Reading 2 1 Peter 2:4-9

Beloved:

Come to him, a living stone, rejected by human beings but chosen and precious in the sight of God, and, like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. For it says in Scripture: Behold, I am laying a stone in Zion, a cornerstone, chosen and precious, and whoever believes in it shall not be put to shame. Therefore, its value is for you who have faith, but for those without faith: The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone, and A stone that will make people stumble, and a rock that will make them fall. They stumble by disobeying the word, as is their destiny. You are "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of his own, so that you may announce the praises" of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Gospel John 14:1-12

Jesus said to his disciples:

"Do not let your hearts be troubled.

You have faith in God; have faith also in me.

In my Father's house there are many dwelling places.

If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be.

Where I am going you know the way."

Thomas said to him, "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?"

Jesus said to him, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

If you know me, then you will also know my Father.

From now on you do know him and have seen him."

Philip said to him, "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.

How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?

Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? the words that I speak to you I do not speak on my own. The Father who dwells in me is doing his works.

Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else, believe because of the works themselves.

Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am going to the Father."

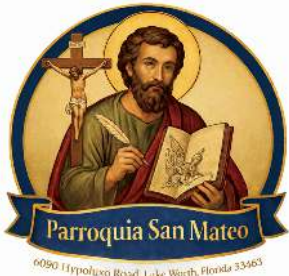
Mother's Day Spiritual Bouquet Cards are available at the *entrance doors* of the church.

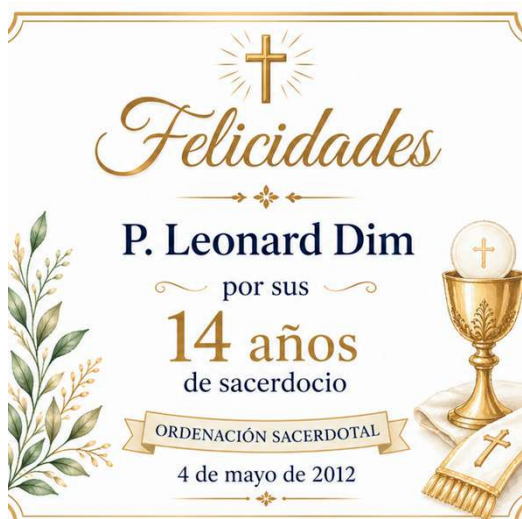

Msgr. Tom's Musings: A SPECIAL WAY TO HONOR OUR CATHOLIC VETS

With Memorial Day less than a month away, our thoughts and prayers turn once again to the memory of the brave men and women who have honored our country through their military service.

Many of us remember when we used to call this day Decoration Day, and we went to cemeteries to place wreaths or miniature flags at the tombstones of those veterans who have gone before us. We often participated in ceremonies that would include parades, speeches, Memorial Masses and even some fireworks, though not quite as elaborate as those on the 4th of July. But, times have changed, and there seems that those traditions have mostly gone by the wayside, and these sacred actions have been replaced by a more festive rhythm that includes barbecues and picnics. Yet, thank God, there are some who would like to return our focus to the original intent of this holiday, especially to properly memorialize the gravestones of our Catholic heroes in "the land of the free and the home of the brave,"

A major Catholic lobbying organization in Washington has spearheaded a push to allow veterans to place crucifixes on their headstones in national veterans cemeteries, an effort that has now drawn a letter from 45 members from both sides of the aisle of Congress, urging the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to act as swiftly and judiciously on this matter as possible. This initiative gained momentum after a Catholic member of the organization, CatholicVote (CV), raised the issue. The organization's staff consulted an ally inside the VA office to understand the approval process, and the constituent prepared a sample headstone design. While the VA accepted the design, officials said the approval process often takes three to four years.

CV then worked with the constituent to contact Congressman Greg Steube of Florida, who sent an April 10th letter to VA Secretary Douglas Collins and Undersecretary for Memorial Affairs Samuel Brown, urging them to add crucifixes to the VA's list of nearly 100 approved emblems that veterans and their next-of-kin can select for headstones. CatholicVote Director of Government Affairs Tom McClusky said Steube's letter was intended to expedite the process, noting that the VA's typical three-to-four-year review timeline could extend into "a new, possibly unsympathetic to Catholics, presidential administration" without intervention.

In the letter, the lawmakers noted that Catholics make up roughly 20% of the U.S. military, and the crucifix serves as a central symbol of their faith. The VA already approves dozens of religious symbols — including a plain cross used by some Protestant groups — and other emblems representative of Judaism, Islam, and Hinduism.

The letter states, "While even atheists, humanists, and wiccans have an eligible emblem of belief for inscription, Catholic veterans do not currently have the option to select a crucifix. In the pursuit of religious freedom, as guaranteed by the First Amendment to our Constitution, we urge the Department of Veterans Affairs and the National Cemetery Administration to offer the crucifix as an eligible emblem of belief for inscription on headstones at national cemeteries."

Lawmakers asked the VA to respond by May 8, with details (1) on its criteria and review process for evaluating and approving new emblems; (2) whether it has received any requests from veterans' families to add a crucifix and the outcomes of those requests; and (3) whether it intends to approve the symbol and, if so, on what timeline.

The letter was signed by 45 federal lawmakers, including 20 Catholic members of Congress. According to a press release from Representative Steube's office, the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA, which ministers to over two million Catholic military personnel and their families, has also endorsed the request. Hopefully, with prayers from those families affected, and from us, a positive response from the VA will be forthcoming in a few days.


